3 4 5 6 7 8 9 10 11 12 13 14	A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE RENEWAL FOR FY 2020/2021 OF THE AGREEMENT WITH THE AETNA FOR GROUP MEDICAL WITH PHARMACY PURSUANT TO RFP FY 2018-2019-004, FOR AN ESTIMATED COST OF APPROXIMATELY \$5,939,581 (FIVE MILLION NINE HUNDRED THIRTY-NINE THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED EIGHTY- ONE) DOLLARS; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO NEGOTIATE AND EXECUTE THE RENEWAL; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

16	WHEREAS, the City of Hallandale Beach currently provides Group Health, Group Dental,
17	Group Vision, Group Flexible Spending Accounts, Group COBRA, and Group Employee Assistance Program (EAP) benefits to approximately 721 members, out of which 340 are eligible
18 19	employees and elected officials, and the rest are retirees and additional eligible dependents; and
20	
20	WHEREAS, last year, the City administration worked with the City's Insurance Consultant,
21	Gallagher Benefit Services, Inc., to initiate a Request For Proposals (RFP) to obtain quotes from
23	Group Health, Group Dental, Group Vision, Group Flexible Spending Accounts, COBRA
24	Administration, Medical Gap Insurance, and Group Employee Assistance Program (EAP)
25	carriers, which was ultimately awarded to AETNA; and
26	
27	WHEREAS, the 2019 insurance contract for group health coverage is due to expire
28	September 30, 2020. The other plans are in multiple year guarantees - Group Dental, Group
29	Vision, Group Flexible Spending Accounts, COBRA Administration, Medical Gap Insurance, and
30	Group Employee Assistance Program (EAP), with Aetna; and
31	
32	WHEREAS, the City Manager, Human Resources Director and Gallagher consultants
33	negotiated the renewal of the existing Group Health plan from the proposed 12.5% (twelve and
34	one-half percent) down to 6% (six percent), the other plans are in multiple year guarantees with
35	Aetna; and
36	

37	WHEREAS, based on the proposed insurance rates increase of 6% in our current Medical		
38	annual premium, staff estimates the annual total benefits cost for Fiscal 2020/2021 to be		
39	approximately \$5,939,581 (approximately an increase from FY 2019/2020 of \$300,000 annually),		
40	although a final amount is pending the final "experience" reported by the plan; and		
41 42	WHEREAS, staff recommends the City Commission adopt the attached Resolution		
43	authorizing the City Manager to execute the renewal agreement with Aetna.		
44			
45	WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Commission have determined that it is in the best interest		
46	of the City and its residents to accept the recommendation of the city administration.		
47			
48	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY		
49	COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA:		
50			
51	SECTION 1 . The foregoing "Whereas" clauses are incorporated herein.		
52			
53	SECTION 2. The Mayor and City Commission hereby authorize the FY 20/21 renewal of		
54	the agreement with AETNA pursuant to RFP FY 2018-2019-004, for an approximate cost of five		
55	million nine hundred thirty-nine thousand five hundred eighty-one (\$5,939,581) dollars, final cost		
56	pending additional negotiation. Authorizing the City Manager to negotiate and execute the		
57	renewal agreement with the AETNA to provide group health, group dental, group vision, group		
58	flexible spending accounts, COBRA administration, medical gap insurance and group employee		
59	assistance program (EAP) benefits.		
60	SECTION 3. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its		
61	passage and adoption.
