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4 5 7 8 9 10 11	A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA, ADOPTING THE 2019 UPDATE OF THE UNIFIED REGIONAL SEA LEVEL RISE PROJECTION PRODUCED BY THE SOUTHEAST FLORIDA REGIONAL CLIMATE CHANGE COMPACT AS THE BASIS FOR SEA LEVEL RISE ADAPTATION PLANNING ACTIVITIES; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.		
12	WHEREAS, sea level rise in Southeast Florida increases the risk of coastal		
13	inundation, compromises the function of drainage and flood control systems, and		
14	compounds saltwater intrusion of the Biscayne Aquifer and potable water wells; and		
15	WHEREAS, sea level rise, if unaddressed, increases the risk for flood-related		
16	losses and service disruptions with broad socio-economic implications; and		
17	WHEREAS, sea level in Southeast Florida has already risen eleven (11) inches		
18	over the last 100 years, including four (4) inches in the last twenty (20) years, and the		
19	rate of rise is expected to continue to accelerate with time; and		
20 21 22 23 24	WHEREAS, a working group of researchers, senior scientists, and lead engineers from federal and regional agencies and local universities convened by the Southeast Florida Regional Climate Change Compact ("Compact") previously authored iterations of Unified Sea Level Rise Projection for Southeast Florida in 2011 and 2015 with continued updates every 5 years; and		
25	WHEREAS, the Compact reconvened this Sea Level Rise Work Group in 2019		
26	to develop an Updated Unified Sea Level Rise Projection for Southeast Florida		
27	("Updated Projection"), which the Work Group released in December 2019; and		
28	WHEREAS, the Updated Projection and associated guidance documents were		
29	designed to be applied across the four counties of the Compact (Broward, Palm Beach,		
30	Miami-Dade and Monroe) to ensure that all major infrastructure projects throughout		
31	Southeast Florida have a common basis for design and construction relative to expected		
32	future sea levels; and		
33	WHEREAS, the Updated Projection, incorporating both lower and upper		
34	boundaries based on global trends and local conditions, is considered appropriate		

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guidance for the majority of land use and infrastructure planning decision andinvestments in the region; and

WHEREAS, the Updated Projection presents mean sea level rise is projected to
be ten (10) to seventeen (17) inches by 2040 and twenty-one (21) to fifty- four (54)
inches by 2070, above the 2000 mean sea level in Key West, Florida, and also includes
sea level rise projections for 2120, as well as a higher curves for informational purposes
to emphasize that emissions mitigation is essential to moderate the severity of potential
impacts in the future; and

WHEREAS, successful implementation of the community-wide Broward County
Climate Action Plan, the Southeast Florida Regional Climate Action Plan, and specific
efforts to reduce risk and bolster community and economic resilience requires significant
action to address sea level rise within the near-term planning horizon (through 2070);
and

WHEREAS, the Broward County Board of County Commissioners adopted the
Updated Projection on March 10, 2020, and directed County staff to use the Updated
Projection as the basis for sea level rise adaptation planning and project design; and

51 WHEREAS, the Unified Sea Level rise Projection for Southeast Florida shall be 52 updated by the Compact Sea Level Rise Work Group, as warranted, based on scientific 53 advancements, and shall be transmitted to the governing bodies of the counties and 54 municipalities of Southeast Florida for acceptance following each revision; and

55 WHEREAS, consistent planning across the region and levels of government is 56 essential for resilient development and adaptation across our communities; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Commission of the City of Hallandale Beach
desire to adopt the Updated Projection on March 10, 2020 and direct staff to use the
Updated projection as the basis for sea level rise adaptation planning and project design.

61NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY62COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA:

63 **SECTION 1.** The foregoing "Whereas" clauses are incorporated herein.

64 SECTION 2. The 2019 Update of the Unified Sea Level Rise Projection for
 65 Southeast Florida ("Updated Projection") is hereby adopted for use in Hallandale Beach,

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66	and municipal staff shall use the Updated Projection as the basis for sea level rise
67	adaptation planning activities.

68	SECTION 3. The Updated Projection shall be considered in agency planning and		
69	decision-making, project plans, and infrastructure design.		
70	SECTION 4. The City Commission agrees to fully consider future revisions of the		
71	Unified Sea Level Projection for Southeast Florida for adoption and use in the city.		
72	SECTION 5. A copy of this resolution shall be transmitted to the Broward County		
73	Board of County Commissioners.		
74	SECTION 6. This resolution takes effect immediately upon its passage and		
75	adoption.
