RESOLUTION NO. 2020 -

**A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE
CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA AUTHORIZING AN
INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT WITH BROWARD COUNTY FOR THE
COST-SHARE OF THE NATURESCAPE IRRIGATION SERVICE;
DIRECTING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE AGREEMENT;
AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

WHEREAS, in 2005, Broward County and twenty-two (22) municipal water utility partners collaborated in the launching of a NatureScape Irrigation Service ("NIS"), a local variation of a Mobile Irrigation Laboratory, through an interlocal agreement ("ILA") which has expired;

WHEREAS, NIS is designed to provide users with a detailed site evaluation and recommendations for achieving water savings and water quality improvements through modifications in landscape and irrigation system design, maintenance, and operation; and

WHEREAS, since 2005, NIS has helped local partners achieve more than 1.6 billion gallons in water savings. In 2018, through NIS, the City was alerted to 18 irrigation leaks at three City Parks, reducing our water usage by more than 3 million gallons of potable water. Additionally, in years past this program has been used to help overall city water consumption be reduced by working with large commercial water users; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Commission desire to direct the City Manager to execute a new 5-year Interlocal Agreement with Broward County for the Cost-Share of the NIS, a total not to exceed 5-year cost of fifteen thousand nine hundred twenty seven dollars and forty one cents (\$15,927.41).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. The foregoing "Whereas" clauses are incorporated herein.

SECTION 2. The Mayor and City Commission hereby direct the City Manager to execute the Interlocal Agreement with Broward County for the Cost-Share of the NIS, at

a total not to exceed 5-year cost of fifteen thousand nine hundred twenty seven dollars and forty one cents (\$15,927.41).

SECTION 3. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage and adoption.
