L0 L1	WHEREAS, in 2005, Broward County and twenty-two (22) municipal water utility
L2	partners collaborated in the launching of a NatureScape Irrigation Service ("NIS"), a local
L3	variation of a Mobile Irrigation Laboratory, through an interlocal agreement ("ILA") which
L4	has expired;

L6	WHEREAS, NIS is designed to provide users with a detailed site evaluation and
L7	recommendations for achieving water savings and water quality improvements through
L8	modifications in landscape and irrigation system design, maintenance, and operation; and

20	WHEREAS, since 2005, NIS has helped local partners achieve more than 1.6
21	billion gallons in water savings. In 2018, through NIS, the City was alerted to 18 irrigation
22	leaks at three City Parks, reducing our water usage by more than 3 million gallons of
23	potable water. Additionally, in years past this program has been used to help overall city
24	water consumption be reduced by working with large commercial water users; and
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26	WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Commission desire to direct the City Manager to
27	execute a new 5-year Interlocal Agreement with Broward County for the Cost-Share of the
28	NIS, a total not to exceed 5-year cost of fifteen thousand nine hundred twenty seven
29	dollars and forty one cents (\$15,927.41).
