8 9	RECOVERY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

11	WHEREAS, a Post Disaster Redevelopment Plan (PDRP) serves as a long-		
12	term recovery framework for various types of disasters to ensure the rebuilding of		
13	a community is done in a resilient manner in line with a city's best vision, rather		
14	than simply restoring an area to the status quo; and		
15			
16	WHEREAS, part or all of a PDRP is activated following any major disaster		
17	to provide a framework and guidance for long-term recovery; and		
18			
19	WHEREAS, on August 15, 2018, the Hallandale Beach City Commission		
20	amended the Coastal Management Element of its Comprehensive Plan to ensure		
21	compliance with peril of floods; and		
22			
23	WHEREAS, as required by the City's Comprehensive Plan, the city		
24	developed a plan for the replacement of infrastructure in the Coastal High Hazard		
25	Areas (CHHA) that integrates additional innovative climate adaptation and		
26	mitigation to the extent financially feasible; and		
27			
28	WHEREAS, as required by the City's Comprehensive Plan, the city		
29	prepared a PDRP for the CHHA that identifies strategies to reduce or eliminate the		
30	exposure of human life, public property, and private property to natural hazards by		
31	2020; and		
32			

33	WHEREAS, utilizing a \$40,000 grant from the Florida Department of			
34	Economic Opportunity, the city contracted with the South Florida Regional			
35	Planning Council (SFRPC) to assist in the creation of the PDRP; and			
36				
37	WHEREAS, the PDRP includes various components which relate to long-			
38	term recovery including Land-Use, Housing, Economic Redevelopment,			
39	Infrastructure & Public Facilities, Health & Social Services and Environment &			
40	Cultural Resources; and			
41				
42	WHEREAS, more than 30 stakeholders from non-profits, the business			
43	community, city staff and partner agencies participated in publicly noticed virtual			
44	workshops in the development of the PDRP; and			
45				
46	WHEREAS, the PDRP has been developed by expert consultants, vetted			
47	by stakeholders, and has the power to be helpful immediately in our long-term			
48	recovery from COVID-19; and			
49				
50	WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Commission desire to adopt the attached			
51	PDRP.

53	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY			
54	COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA:

56	<b>SECTION 1.</b> The foregoing "Whereas" clauses are incorporated herein.

58	SECTION 2. The Mayor and City Commission hereby adopt the proposed			
59	Post Disaster Redevelopment Plan attached as Exhibit A.

61	SECTION 3. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect immediately
