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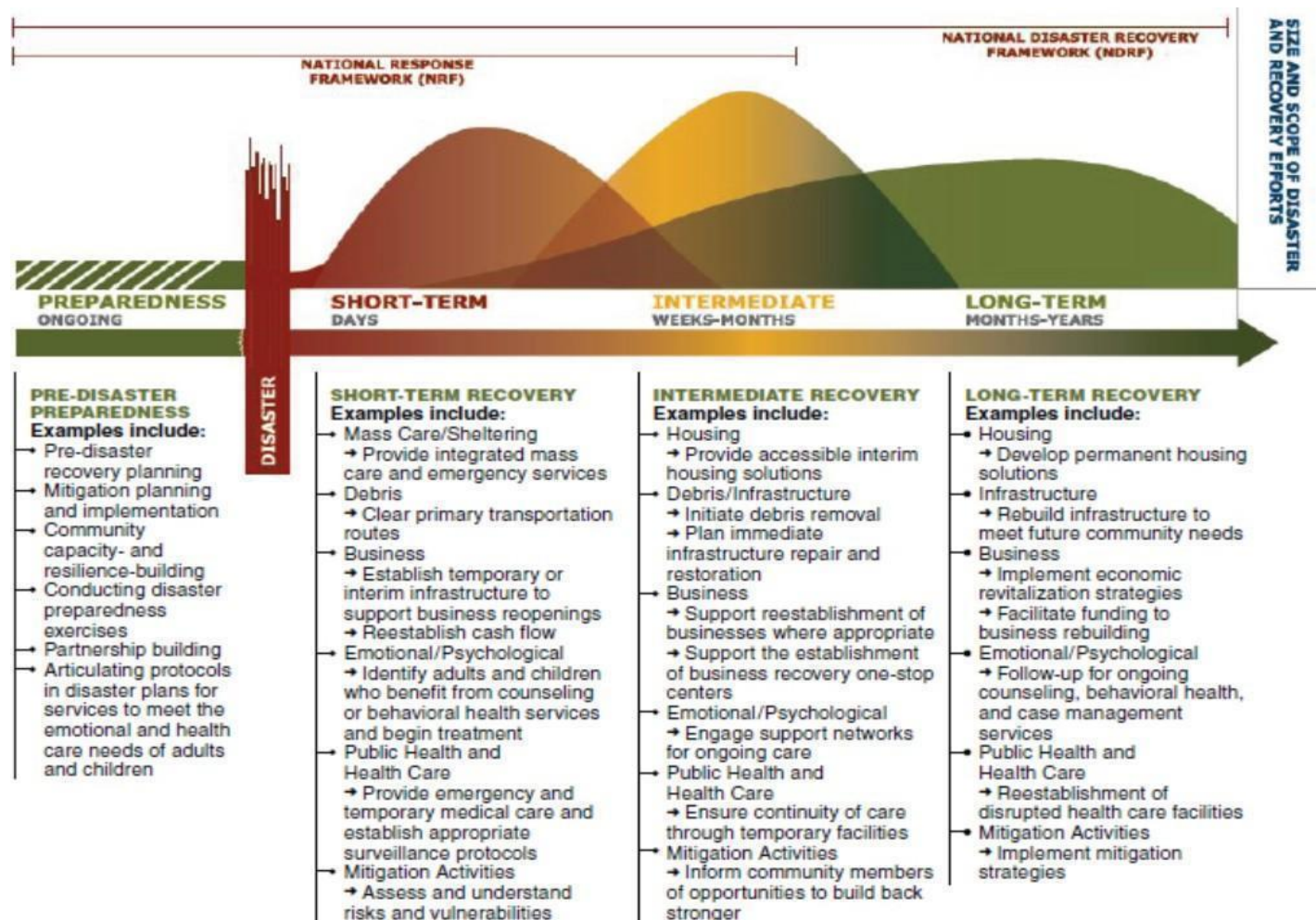
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What is the Post-Disaster Redevelopment Plan?

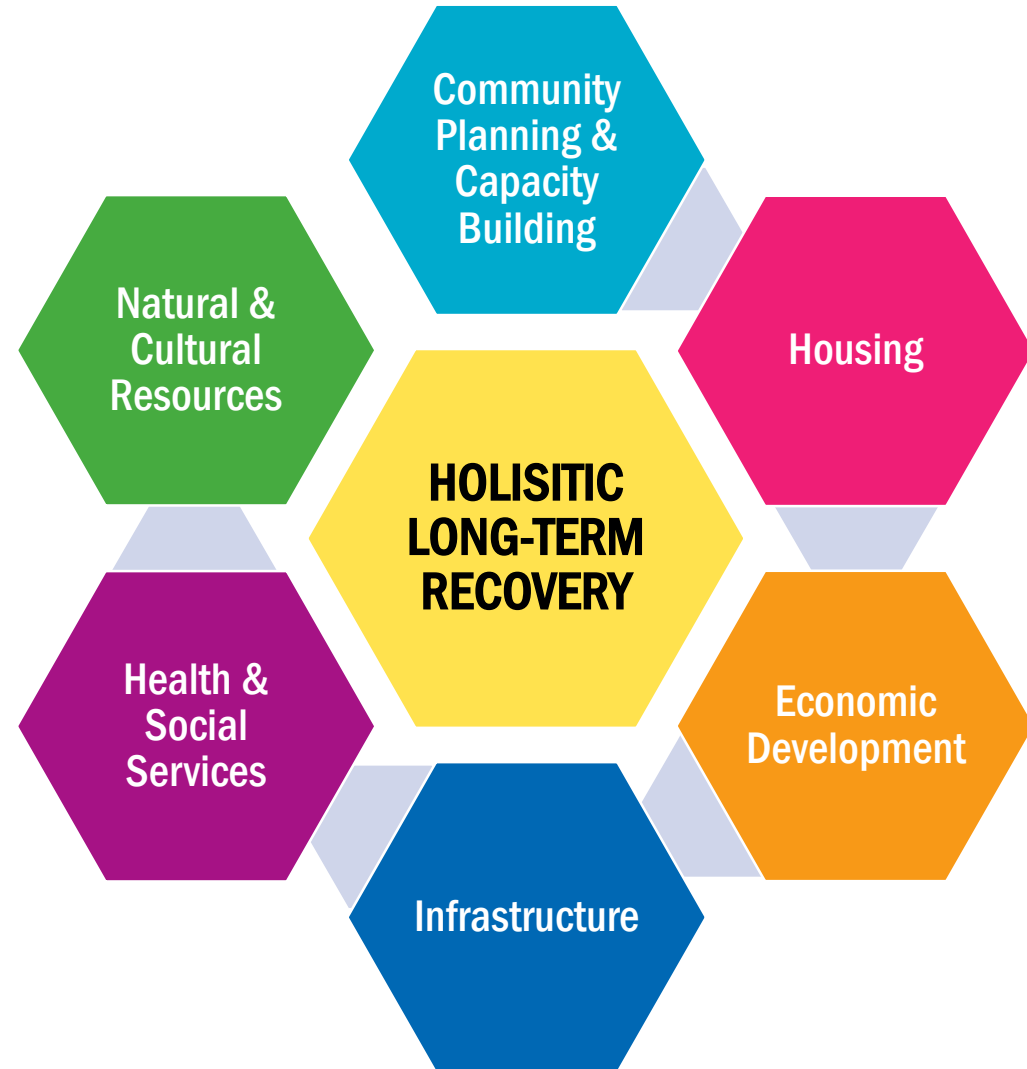
- Focused on long-term recovery with a timeline of years or decades.
- Goal is to re-establish a healthy, functioning community that will sustain itself over time by building back in a way that increases resilience to future disasters.
- An opportunity to advance community visions and priorities on a faster timeline.





Long-term Recovery Focus Areas

The National Disaster Recovery Framework organizes long-term recovery around six topic areas that address holistic long-term recovery in a community.



Guiding Principles for Long-Term Recovery

1. Financial Stability and Organizational Capacity
2. Infrastructure
3. Development and Redevelopment
4. Economic Development

Plan Maintenance

- Integrate key long-term recovery roles and responsibilities into job descriptions.
 - Require review of this guide as part of the process of onboarding new employees.
 - Provide a copy of this guide to current key staff.
 - Offer an annual training on long-term recovery.
 - Appoint Disaster Recovery Team Coordinators at the start of hurricane season each year.
 - Update this plan to reflect program evolution.
