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4 5 6 7 8 9 10 11 12	AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA, AMENDING CHAPTER 2 ADMINISTRATION, ARTICLE II CITY COMMISSION, SECTION 2-31 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES, ENTITLED COMPENSATION AND EXPENSES OF THE CITY COMMISSION TO REVISE THE PROCESS FOR SETTING OF COMPENSATION; PROVIDING FOR CODIFICATION; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICT; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.
14	WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Commission find that the City's Code of Ordinances
15	providing for the compensation and expenses of the City Commission should be revised to
16	address benefits.

18	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION
19	OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA:
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21	SECTION 1. Chapter 2 Administration, Article II. City Commission, Section 2-31,
22	Compensation and expenses of the City's Code of Ordinances is replaced in it's entirety
23	with the following:
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25	ARTICLE II. CITY COMMISSION
26	Sec. 2-31. Compensation and expenses.
27	The salary of the Mayor and Commissioners shall be presented as part of the annual
28	budget. The salary presented will be the same as the previous year salary, but adjusted to
29	include the same annual cost-of-living adjustment as applicable to members of the general
30	employee bargaining unit and may be approved as part of the annual budget. However, in
31	the event the Mayor or a commissioner wish to adopt a salary that differs from the salary in
32	the previous sentence, the subject must be included and voted on as a separate item on the
33	agenda at the first of the two public hearings of the annual budget.
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35	The Mayor and Commissioners shall be eligible for all health and non-pension retirement
36	benefits applicable to members of the general employee bargaining unit. However,

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38	they show proof they are otherwise covered by health insurance for the year.
39	Commissioners shall be reimbursed for their actual and necessary expenses incurred in the
40	performance of their duties of office as preauthorized by the city commission.
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42	SECTION 2. Conflict. All ordinances or portions of the Code of Ordinances of the
43	City of Hallandale Beach in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance shall be repealed to
44	the extent of such conflict.
45	SECTION 3. Severability. Should any provision of this ordinance be declared by a
46	court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, the same shall not affect the validity of the
47	ordinance as a whole, or any part thereof, other that the part declared to be invalid.
48	SECTION 4. Codification. It is the intention of the Mayor and the City Commission
49	that the provisions of this ordinance be incorporated into the Code of Ordinances; to effect
50	such intention the words "ordinance" or "section" may be changed to other appropriate
51	words.
52	SECTION 5. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon
53	adoption on second reading.
