AN **ORDINANCE** OF THE **MAYOR** AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA, AMENDING CHAPTER 10 - FINANCE AND TAXATION, ARTICLE II - BUDGET TRANSFERS, SECTION 10-33 - CAPITAL PROGRAM, SUBSECTION (a), CODE OF ORDINANCES, CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICT; PROVIDING FOR CODIFICATION: PROVIDING FOR **SEVERABILITY:** PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

### **STAFF SUMMARY:**

#### **Background and Summary**

Florida Statutes Section 163.3177(3)(b) and the City of Hallandale Beach's Comprehensive Plan Capital Improvement Element require that a five-year schedule of Capital Improvement projects be maintained annually. The modification to update the five-year capital improvement schedule may be accomplished by ordinance. However, Chapter 10 - Finance and Taxation, Article II - Budget Transfers, Section 10-33 - Capital Program, Subsection (a), Code of Ordinances, City of Hallandale Beach, Florida, presently allows the City Commission to adopt the five-year capital program by resolution and City Administration desires to amend the Code of Ordinances to act in agreement with the Florida statutes to update the five-year improvement schedule by ordinance instead of resolution.

#### PROPOSED ACTION:

The City Commission consider and approve the attached Ordinance to modify Chapter 10 – Finance and Taxation, Article II – Budget Transfers, Section 10-33 – Capital Program, Subsection (a), Code of Ordinances
