SHORT TITLE:

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING AWARD OF BID # FY2019-2020-005, FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE WELL #9 PIPELINE, TO HINTERLAND GROUP, INC., THE LOWEST RESPONSIVE BIDDER, FOR AN AMOUNT NOT-TO-EXCEED \$646,586 (SIX HUNDRED FORTY-SIX THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED EIGHTY-SIX) INCLUDING CONTINGENCY; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO NEGOTIATE AN AGREEMENT WITH HINTERLAND GROUP, INC. DOLLARS; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

STAFF SUMMARY:

Summary:

This agenda item seeks City Commission approval to award BID # FY2019-2020-005 - RAW WATER WELL # 9 PIPELINE, for the construction of the Well #9 Pipeline, to Hinterland Group, Inc., the lowest responsive bidder, in the amount of \$587,806. Staff seeks approval to add a 10% (\$58,780) contingency to the construction project and to authorize the City Manager and the City Attorney to negotiate an agreement with Hinterland Group for a not-to-exceed total of \$646,586.

Background:

The City of Hallandale Beach is increasing in population and has a healthy amount of proposed development underway. In order to keep up with the City's water consumption demand the City is proposing to add an additional Biscayne Aquifer production well (PW #9) within the City's limits. In order to covey the water from PW #9 the City will need to construct a 3,000 linear foot 12-inch pipeline connecting the new well PW #9 and the existing well PW #8 to the City's Water Treatment Plant. Current Situation:

Staff has reviewed the bids and the attached Award Information Memorandum (Exhibit 3). The Department of Public Works recommends awarding BID # FY2019-2020-005 to the lowest responsive bidder, Hinterland Group, Inc.

Why Action is Necessary:

Pursuant to Chapter 23, Section 23-4, Competitive Bidding Required, all purchases of and contracts for equipment, supplies and contractual services, when the estimated cost shall exceed \$50,000.00 shall be based on competitive bids. Furthermore, pursuant to Chapter 23, Section 23-6, Award of Contract, the City Manager, shall have the authority to recommend to the City Commission award of contracts.

Cost Benefit:

The benefits from construction of the 12-inch raw water pipeline is that it will increase our water production which will ensure that the needs of increased development intensity are met throughout the City.

PROPOSED ACTION:

Staff recommends approval of the attached resolution awarding BID # FY2019-2020-005 - RAW WATER WELL # 9 PIPELINE, for the construction of the Raw Water Well #9 Pipeline, to Hinterland Group, the lowest responsive bidder, in the amount \$587,806. Staff also recommends adding a 10% (\$58,780) contingency to the construction project and authorizing the City Manager and the City Attorney to negotiate an agreement with Hinterland Group, Inc. for a not-to-exceed total of \$646,586.
