

RESOLUTION NO. 2013 - 87

A **RESOLUTION** OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A FULLY AMENDED REGIONAL INTER-LOCAL AGREEMENT (RILA), ATTACHED AS EXHIBIT 2, **WITH** BROWARD COUNTY OFFICE OF COMMUNICATION TECHNOLOGY (BCOCT) FOR CONTINUED SERVICES, SUPPORT, AND PARTICIPATION IN A REGIONAL PUBLIC SAFETY INTRANET; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, on February 16, 2009, an inter-local fire-centric agreement between the City and the Broward Sheriff's office (hereinafter "BSO") was executed to support Closest Unit Response (hereinafter "CUR"); and

WHEREAS, on February 26, 2013, the City entered into an Interlocal Agreement with Broward County as a result of taking over the Regional Communications from Broward Sheriff's office (hereinafter "BSO"); and

WHEREAS, the County and each municipality participating agreed to expand the Inter-Local agreement to include all shared communications related functions, and each municipality participating is required to execute the Regional Inter-Local Agreement (hereinafter "RILA"); and

WHEREAS, on August 21, 2013, the City Commission authorizing the City Manager to execute the Assignment of the RILA to facilitate the procurement and implementation of a fully functional Mobile Field Reporting System (hereinafter "MFRS"), and the RILA Assignment is only to transfer the assigned agreement from BSO to Broward County; and

WHEREAS, the City Administration request authorization to execute a fully amended RILA so that the City will continue to receive services and support from the Broward County Office of Communication Technology (hereinafter "BCOCT"), and will continue to participate in the Regional Public Safety Intranet as it is in the best interest of the City of Hallandale Beach and its residents.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. City Manager Authorization.

The Mayor and City Commission hereby authorize the City Manager to execute a fully amended RILA, attached as Exhibit 2, so that the City will continue to receive services and support from the Broward County Office of Communication Technology (hereinafter "BCOCT"), and will continue to participate in the Regional Public Safety Intranet as it is in the best interest of the City of Hallandale Beach and its residents.

SECTION 2. Effective Date.


This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage and adoption.
