15	WHEREAS, Broward County created the Broward County Consolidated Communication
16	Implementation Advisory Board (hereinafter "I-Board") consisting of municipal
17	managers/administrators from local municipalities to review, consider and make
18	recommendations relating to the creation, governance, funding and operations of the E-911
19	communication system; and
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21	WHEREAS, the I-Board issued a report in February 2013 which contained a series of
22	recommendations which included a recommendation that Broward County create and wholly
23	fund a countywide consolidation of E-911 communications; and
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25	WHEREAS, the City Commissions of twenty three (23) of the thirty one (31) Cities
26	passed resolutions requesting that Broward County fund the cooperative countywide
27	consolidation of E-911; and
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29	WHEREAS, Broward County determined the current fragmented system of emergency
30	call-processing and dispatching is inefficient, costly, and may result in delays involving the
31	transfer of calls among numerous dispatch centers; and
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33	WHEREAS, the establishment and maintenance of a Consolidated Regional E-911
34	Communication System will promote the health, safety, and general welfare throughout Broward
35	by improving the safety of first responders; and
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37 WHEREAS, Broward County shall wholly fund, operate or contract to operate the 38 consolidated communication system for fire, police, and EMS dispatch under the agreement 39 with Broward County; and

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41 WHEREAS, City Administration request authorization to execute an agreement with 42 Broward County to participate in the consolidated Regional E-911 Communication System as in 43 the best interest of the City, its residents, and visitors that travel through or spend time within 44 the boundaries of the City of Hallandale and Broward County.

residents, and visitors.
