

RESOLUTION NO. 2013 - 88

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO **EXECUTE** AN AGREEMENT IN SUBSTANTIALLY THE SAME FORM AS ATTACHED AS EXHIBIT 2, BETWEEN BROWARD COUNTY AND THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH TO PARTICIPATE IN THE CONSOLIDATED REGIONAL E-911 COMMUNICATION SYSTEM FOR FIRE, POLICE, AND EMS DISPATCH; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Broward County created the Broward County Consolidated Communication Implementation Advisory Board (hereinafter "I-Board") consisting of municipal managers/administrators from local municipalities to review, consider and make recommendations relating to the creation, governance, funding and operations of the E-911 communication system; and

WHEREAS, the I-Board issued a report in February 2013 which contained a series of recommendations which included a recommendation that Broward County create and wholly fund a countywide consolidation of E-911 communications; and

WHEREAS, the City Commissions of twenty three (23) of the thirty one (31) Cities passed resolutions requesting that Broward County fund the cooperative countywide consolidation of E-911; and

WHEREAS, Broward County determined the current fragmented system of emergency call-processing and dispatching is inefficient, costly, and may result in delays involving the transfer of calls among numerous dispatch centers; and

WHEREAS, the establishment and maintenance of a Consolidated Regional E-911 Communication System will promote the health, safety, and general welfare throughout Broward by improving the safety of first responders; and

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37           **WHEREAS**, Broward County shall wholly fund, operate or contract to operate the  
38 consolidated communication system for fire, police, and EMS dispatch under the agreement  
39 with Broward County; and  
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41           **WHEREAS**, City Administration request authorization to execute an agreement with  
42 Broward County to participate in the consolidated Regional E-911 Communication System as in  
43 the best interest of the City, its residents, and visitors that travel through or spend time within  
44 the boundaries of the City of Hallandale and Broward County.  
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46           **NOW, 'THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY**  
47 **COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA:**

48           **SECTION 1. City Manager Authorization.**   The Mayor and City Commission hereby  
49 authorize the City Manager to execute an agreement with Broward County, in substantially the  
50 same form as attached hereto as Exhibit 2, to participate in the consolidated Regional E-911  
51 Communication System for fire, police and EMS dispatch, as in the best interest of the City, its  
52 residents, and visitors.  
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54           **SECTION 2. Effective Date.**   This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its  
55 passage and adoption.
