13	WHEREAS, WHEREAS, since 1968, the City of Hallandale Beach has maintained
14	the Water Treatment Plant's (WTP's) transfer pumps, which move treated water from the
15	clearwell to above ground storage tanks; and
16	
17	WHEREAS, the transfer pumps service a vital role in providing the residents clean
18	and safe drinking water; and
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20	WHEREAS, the transfer pumps are beyond the end of their normal economic lives,
21	which is typically 20-30 years; and
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23	WHEREAS, City staff have reported that current pump capacities have decreased
24 25	to approximately 80% of their original design capacities; and
25 26	WHEREAS, the City has decided to install three transfer pumps equipped with
20	variable frequency drives (VFDs), which will allow transfer sump level to be controlled by
28	pump speed and to operate more efficiently at reduced speed when the storage tank is
29	partially full and at higher speed for filter backwash as required; and
30	
31	WHEREAS, the new water treatment plant transfer pumps will be more efficient
32	than the existing ones, and over time will realize an energy cost saving to the Water
33	Treatment Plant operations; and
34	
35	WHEREAS, City staff recommends retaining the services of Hazen and Sawyer
36	to provide inspection services during the construction of the Transfer Pump Project, in

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37 38	accordance with RFP #2013-2014-006 – Continuing Services Agreements for a not-to- exceed of \$185,615.
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40	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY
41	COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA:

43	SECTION 1. The foregoing "Whereas" clauses are incorporated herein.

45	SECTION 2. The Mayor and City Commission hereby authorize retaining the
46 47	services of Hazen and Sawyer to provide inspection services during the construction of the Transfer Pump Project, in accordance with RFP #2013-2014-006 – Continuing
48	Services Agreements for a not-to-exceed of \$185,615 (one hundred eighty-five thousand
49	six hundred fifteen) dollars.
