4	A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF
5 6	HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA, DECLARING A UNIQUE CIRCUMSTANCE FOR THE BROKERAGE OF MUNICIPAL INSURANCE PRODUCTS;
7	APPROVING THE RENEWAL OF THE CITY'S PROPERTY INSURANCE WITH
8	FLORIDA MUNICIPAL TRUST FUND IN THE AMOUNT OF SEVEN HUNDRED
9 10	THREE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED SIXTY (\$703,860) DOLLARS; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ALL RELATED
11	DOCUMENTS TO EFFECTUATE THE INSURANCE AS PROVIDED FOR IN
12 13	FISCAL YEAR 2020-21 BUDGET; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

15	WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 23-6, Award of Contracts, and 23-8, Unique
16	Circumstances, the City Commission may declare unique circumstances as an exception to the
17	requirements of competitive bidding;
18	
19	WHEREAS, unlike the procurement of most services, insurance products must be
20	obtained through a broker who is paid a commission by the insurance company and not the city;
21	
22	WHEREAS, the City participates in the Florida Municipal Insurance Trust Fund, which is
23	administered by the Florida League of Cities and limited only to municipalities, to insure its
24	physical facilities; and
25	
26	WHEREAS, this trust fund provides property insurance for all City facilities which currently
27	totals \$94,015,824 for buildings and \$6,638,000 for content coverage. There is a \$25,000
28	deductible per incident except for windstorm damage, which is 5% per value of the building
29	deductible; and
30	
31	WHEREAS, the premium to renew coverage increased as a result of increased property
32	rates, the addition of Bluesten Park facility, and the increase in value to Ingalls Park and Marina
33	Dock facilities; and
34	
35	WHEREAS, the property insurance for all City facilities provided by this trust fund
36	represents the cost to replace damaged property with property of like kind and quality; and

38	WHEREAS, the City Administration is recommending that the City renew its current
39	property insurance with Florida Municipal Trust Fund for the total sum of Seven Hundred Three
40	Thousand Eight Hundred Sixty (\$703,860) Dollars for fiscal year 2020-2021; and
41 42	WHEREAS, the City believes it is in the best interest of the City to renew the City's current
43	property insurance through the Florida Municipal Insurance Trust Fund.
44 45	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY
46	COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA:
47 48 49	SECTION 1. The foregoing "Whereas" clauses are adopted herein.
50	SECTION 2. Declaration of Unique Circumstances. The Mayor and City
51	Commission declare a Unique Circumstance pursuant to Chapter 23, Section 8(5) of the City of
52	Hallandale Beach Code of Ordinances.
53	
54	SECTION 3. City Manager Authorization. The Mayor and City Commission hereby
55	approve the renewal of the City's property insurance through the Florida Municipal Insurance
56	Trust Fund in the amount of Seven Hundred Three Thousand Eight Hundred Sixty (\$703,860)
57	Dollars and authorize the City Manager to execute all related documents to effectuate the renewal
58	of the City's property insurance.
59 60	SECTION 4. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its
61	passage and adoption.
