SHORT TITLE:

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA, SETTING AND AMENDING THE WATER AND WASTEWATER RATES AND ADOPTING A WATER AND WASTEWATER RATE INCREASE FOR FISCAL YEAR 2020/2021; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

STAFF SUMMARY:

Summary:

For fiscal year 2015/2016, the City of Hallandale Beach (the "City") did not meet the bank covenant for two of the City's outstanding loans. As a result, the City was required to conduct a review of the Water, Wastewater (sewer), and Stormwater rates. The review identified the need

for the Water and Wastewater rate adjustments and no need for adjustments to the Storwater rates.

Background:

The City's Water, Wastewater, and Stormwater utilities should have revenues equal to the costs of the services provided and should establish rates sufficient to cover the cost of operating, maintaining, repairing, and financing system operations. Additionally, revenues must meet debt service coverage requirements of the City's existing and proposed debt.

For fiscal year 2015/2016, the City of Hallandale Beach (the "City") did not meet the bank covenant for two of the City's outstanding loans. In accordance with the loan agreement, if in any fiscal year, the City fails to comply with the rate covenant, the City must conduct a rate study. Consequently, the City conducted a review/study of the Water, Wastewater and Stormwater systems. The Analysis encompassed financial evaluation for the five (5) fiscal year period of October 1, 2017 though September 30, 2022. The review identified the need for Water and Wastewater rate adjustments and not need for adjustments to the Stormwater rates.

During the August 15, 2018 City Commission meeting, the Water, Wastewater and Stormwater utility rate study was presented and the proposed 3% and 2% rate increase for Water and Wastewater respectively, were discussed. Accordingly, a determination was made and the rate increase was added to the fiscal year 2019/2020 budget. The rate increase will apply to fiscal years 2019/20, 2020/21 & 2021/22.
