23	exceed eighty-nine thousand six hundred (\$89,600) dollars for custodial supplies from
24 25	Home Depot Pro Institutional utilizing U.S. Communities Contract RFP # 17-21; and
26	WHEREAS, authorized City staff received a log in to utilize the Home Depot Pro
27	Institutional contracted pricing and make purchases on-line. Some of the purchases made
28	by City staff are paper towels, facial tissues, wipers, dispensing equipment, seat covers,
29	brooms and dust pans, can liners, restroom cleaners, and other related items on-line.

31	WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Commission find that it is in the best interest of
32	the City of Hallandale Beach to authorize the utilization of the requested contract.

44	effectuate the purchase.
