WHEREAS, the mission of the Hallandale Beach Community Redevelopment Agency ("HBCRA") is to promote and enhance the quality of life by eliminating and preventing slum and blighted conditions in the Community Redevelopment Area through redevelopment activities and projects pursuant to Part III of Chapter 163, Florida Statutes, known as the Community Redevelopment Act of 1969; and

WHEREAS, to remain efficient and effective with its housing initiatives, the HBCRA desires to support the development by the South Florida Community Land Trust of a 85 unit permanently affordable residential project located at 214 East Hallandale Beach Boulevard, Hallandale Beach, Florida, which support is in the form of funding in an amount not to exceed \$700,000; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of the HBCRA desires to (a) approve the funding in an 36 amount not to exceed \$700,000 for the development by the South Florida Community Land Trust 37 of a 85 unit permanently affordable residential project located at 214 East Hallandale Beach 38 Boulevard, Hallandale Beach, Florida, which funding is subject to certain conditions as set forth 39 40 in this resolution and shall be paid in equal installments of \$233,333 each in Fiscal Year 2021-22, Fiscal Year 22-23 and Fiscal Year 2023-24 and (b) authorize the negotiation, finalization and 41 execution of an agreement with the South Florida Community Land Trust to provide funding for 42 the development of the 85 unit permanently affordable residential project in an amount not-to-43 exceed \$700,000. 44

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## 46 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CHAIR AND BOARD OF DIRECTORS 47 OF THE HALLANDALE BEACH COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY:

48 Section 1. <u>Recitals</u>. The recitals in the whereas clauses are true and correct, and 49 incorporated into this resolution.

Section 2. Approval of Funding. The funding by the HBCRA in an amount not to exceed 50 \$700,000 for the development by the South Florida Community Land Trust of a 85 unit 51 permanently affordable residential project located at 214 East Hallandale Beach Boulevard, 52 Hallandale Beach, Florida, which funding shall be paid in equal installments of \$233,333 each in 53 Fiscal Year 2021-22, Fiscal Year 22-23 and Fiscal Year 2023-24, is hereby approved; provided, 54 however, such approval is contingent upon the South Florida Community Land Trust receiving an 55 56 award from the Florida Housing Finance Corporation (FHFC) based on its submitted application 57 and, if such award is not received from the FHFC, the funding approval is rescinded; provided, further, that this contingency may be changed by subsequent negotiations. 58

59 Section 3. <u>Negotiation and Finalization of Agreement</u>. The Executive Director and 60 HBCRA Attorney are hereby authorized to negotiate and finalize an agreement with the South 61 Florida Community Land Trust of a 85 unit permanently affordable residential project located at 62 214 East Hallandale Beach Boulevard, Hallandale Beach, Florida.

63 Section 4. <u>Execution of Agreement</u>. The Executive Director is hereby authorized to 64 execute the agreement with the South Florida Community Land Trust of a 85 unit permanently 65 affordable residential project in an amount not-to-exceed \$700,000.

66 Section 5. <u>Implementation of Agreement</u>. The Executive Director is hereby authorized to 67 take all action necessary to implement the terms of the agreement.

68 Section 6. <u>Effective Date</u>. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon approval.
