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4 5 6 7 8 9 10 11	A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA AUTHORIZING INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT WITH THE HALLANDALE BEACH COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY FOR FUNDING OF COVID-19 GRANT PROGRAMS FROM BROWARD COUNTY CORONAVIRUS AID, RELIEF AND ECONOMIC SECURITY SUBAWARD AGREEMENT; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.
12	WHEREAS, the City and Broward County (the "County") entered into that certain
13	Subaward Agreement dated October 29, 2020 pursuant to which the County will subaward
14	to the City a portion of the funds the County received from the Coronavirus Aid, Relief and
15	Economic Security ("CARES") Act; and
16	
17	WHEREAS, the Hallandale Beach Community Redevelopment Agency (HBCRA)
18	is a dependent special district of the City which, at the time of business closures resulting
19	from the deadly Coronavirus/COVID-19 pandemic, had existing staffing and experience in
20	the administration and distribution of grants to businesses and residents of the Community
21	Redevelopment Area. Further, the HBCRA had the ability to immediately reallocate Tax
22	Increment Funding received annually from the City, originally intended for other purposes,
23	to address the urgent and imminent needs arising in the community; and
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25	WHEREAS, in response to the deadly Coronavirus/COVID-19 pandemic the
26	HBCRA staff worked in coordination with the City administration to determine the
27	immediate needs of the community and the available resources of all parties; and
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29	WHEREAS, the HBCRA Board approved the creation of (a) the Coronavirus
30	Neighborhood and Housing Stabilization Program consisting of three components, (i) the
31	Mortgage Assistance Program with grant amounts up to \$3,900, (ii) the Rental Assistance
32	Program with grant amounts up to \$3,900 and (iii) the Utility Assistant Program with grant
33	amounts up to \$450 and (b) the Coronavirus Small Business Sustainability and Recovery
34	Loan Program consisting of two components, (i) the Business Employment Bridge Loan
35	Program with loan amounts up to \$50,000 and (ii) the Emergency Business Cash Infusion
36	Program with amounts up to \$15,000; and

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38	WHEREAS, the Programs are eligible for funding pursuant to the Subaward
39	Agreement and the Mayor and City Commission find it is in the best interest of the
40	residents of the City of Hallandale Beach to include the Coronavirus Neighborhood and
41	Housing Stabilization Program and the Coronavirus Small Business Sustainability and
42	Recovery Loan Program (collectively, the "Programs") as Projects of the Subaward
43	Agreement and enter into an interlocal agreement (ILA) to document the arrangement
44	between the entities.
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46	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY
47	COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA:
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49	SECTION 1. The foregoing "Whereas" clauses are incorporated herein.
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51	SECTION 2. The Mayor and City Commission hereby approve the ILA with the
52	HBCRA and submission of the Programs pursuant to the terms of the Subaward
53	agreement. The City Manager is authorized to execute all necessary documents to
54	effectuate the funding.

56	SECTION 3. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon
57	its passage and adoption.
