16	hate, bigotry, and harassment based on race, color, religion, national origin, ethnicity, sex,		
17	gender, gender identity and expression, sexual orientation, disability, or any other

20	WHEREAS, the City of Hallandale Beach wishes to affirm its commitment to the		
21	well-being and safety of all of its community members and to ensure that they will be

36	WHEREAS, the January 6, 2021 domestic terrorism incident at our nation's Capito		
37	does not reflect the values of the City of Hallandale Beach; and

39	WHEREAS, ADL's report on Murder and Extremism in the United States in 2019		
40	found that domestic extremists killed at least 42 people in the United States in 17 separate		
41	incidents in 2019, making 2019 the sixth deadliest year on record for domestic extremist-		
42	related killings since 1970; and		
43			
44	WHEREAS, the ADL report found that the extremist-related murders of 2019 were		
45	overwhelmingly (90%) linked to right-wing extremists, with all but one of the incidents tied		
46	to right-wing extremism, and 81% of extremist-related murders in 2019 committed by white		
47	supremacists specifically; and		
48			
49	WHEREAS, disinformation, misinformation, and online conspiracy theories such		
50	as QAnon are spreading and inspiring real-world violence; and

52	WHEREAS, the City of Hallandale Beach supports the peaceful exercise of free		
53	speech, free assembly, and freedom to worship safely for all people; and

55	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY		
56	COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA:

The City of Hallandale Beach affirms its ongoing commitment to cultivating an inclusive, safe, and just society and culture – including within the City of Hallandale Beach operations and institutions – that values the diversity of our community, works to ensure equitable opportunities in all major facets of society, and celebrates both our individuality and commonality.

64 65	Section 2. The City of Hallandale Beach denounces the January 6, 2021 domestic terrorism incident at our nation's Capitol.

67 68 69	Section 3. The City of Hallandale Beach denounces anti-government extremism, white supremacy, racism, antisemitism, misogyny, Islamophobia, anti-LGBTQ+ hate, ableism, and all hateful speech and bias-motivated violent actions in our community.

71	Section 4. The City of Hallandale Beach denounces extremist conspiracy theories,
72	misinformation, and disinformation that cultivate an alienated and mistrustful
73	electorate, undermine democratic institutions and processes, and increase the
74	likelihood of violence.

- 56 <u>Section 5</u>. The City of Hallandale Beach denounces attempts to exploit governmental
 57 procedure and basic government functions for personal political gain.

Section 6. The City of Hallandale Beach commits to fostering an environment within
 the City of Hallandale Beach operations and institutions that does not tolerate anti government extremist, white supremacist, racist, antisemitic, misogynist,
 Islamophobic, anti-LGBTQ+, ableist, and other hateful speech and actions.

- 84 **Section 7.** The City of Hallandale Beach commits to countering hate and extremism 85 by offering an ongoing public lecture series on anti-bias and anti-racist strategies.

87 <u>Section 8</u>. The City of Hallandale Beach commits to countering hate and extremism 88 through engagement with community leaders, governmental transparency and public 89 information-sharing regarding efforts to fight extremism, and the investigation and 90 prosecution of those who commit criminal acts, consistent with civil liberties 91 protections.

93 <u>Section 9.</u> The City of Hallandale Beach urges residents to join us by adopting these
 94 values in their own lives, calling attention to these harms, and denouncing hate and
 95 extremism to help keep us all safe.
