15 16	WHEREAS, the First Amendment to the United States Constitution guarantees
17	and protects basic liberties, including the freedom of religion, speech, press, petition,
18	and assembly; and

20	WHEREAS, together, these guaranteed freedoms make the people of the
21	United States of America the freest in the world; and

23	WHEREAS, without the First Amendment, religious minorities could be
24	persecuted, protesters could be silenced, the press could not criticize the government,
25 26	and citizens could not mobilize for social change; and
20 27	WHEREAS, the First Amendment is of utmost importance to the maintenance
28	of a democratic government; and

30	WHEREAS, the First Amendment protects and guarantees the Constitutional
31	right of all American citizens to peacefully protest, regardless of race, sexual
32	orientation, religious beliefs or nationality; and
33	WITCHEAS the Mayor and City Commission offirms its commitment to
34 35	WHEREAS , the Mayor and City Commission affirms its commitment to safeguarding every American's First Amendment Rights, and hereby request that law
36	enforcement treat all protesters the same, regardless of race, sexual orientation,
37	religious beliefs, or nationality.

40	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY
41	COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA:

43	SECTION 1. The foregoing "Whereas" clauses are incorporated herein and
44	confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a part of this Resolution.

46 **SECTION 2.** The Mayor and City Commission hereby reaffirms its commitment 47 to protecting the First Amendment Rights to promote equal rights for all

49 **SECTION 3.** The Mayor and City commission hereby reaffirms that the First 50 Amendment protects and guarantees the constitutional right of all American citizens to 51 peacefully protest, and hereby request that law enforcement treat all protestors the same, 52 regardless of race, sexual orientation, religious beliefs or nationality.

54 **SECTION 4.** The Mayor and City Commission further directs the City Clerk to 55 transmit a copy of this Resolution to the President, Joe Biden, the Florida Governor, the 56 President of the Florida Senate, the Speaker of the Florida House of Representatives, the 57 Broward County League of Cities, the Florida League of Cities, the Broward County 58 Legislative Delegation, the Board of County commissioners for Broward County, and each 59 of the municipalities in Broward County.

61 **SECTION 5.** This shall take effect immediately upon its passage and adoption.
