## EXHIBIT 1 1 **RESOLUTION NO. 2021-**2 3 A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF 4 THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING 5 UTILIZATION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE'S 6 CONTRACT WITH HINTERLAND GROUP. 7 INC., FOR 8 MAINTENANCE OF LARGE DIAMETER STORM WATER PIPES IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED TWO HUNDRED SIXTY TWO 9 THOUSAND, ONE HUNDRED TWENTY DOLLARS (\$262,120); 10 AUTHORIZING CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE RELATED 11 12 **DOCUMENTS: AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.** 13 WHEREAS, the Northeast section of the City's underground stormwater 14 15 piping is an integral part of its flood management operations; and WHEREAS, the effective functionality of this system is a necessary part of 16 17 the strategy to remove stormwater from the City; and WHEREAS, stormwater systems, often as a part of their operation, 18 accumulate silt and debris over time, and the infrastructure where this 19 accumulation occurs is underground requiring a large-scale operation to effectively 20 21 perform the cleaning; and WHEREAS, while the City of Hallandale Beach has been routinely 22 maintaining and cleaning the smaller diameter (15" and under) storm water pipes, 23 24 City staff was never equipped nor had in place any means to clean the larger diameter pipe in the drainage system; and 25 WHEREAS, the accumulation of debris and sediments inside these large 26 diameter pipes reduces the effective flow of stormwater, which increases the 27 opportunity of flooding hazards during rainy seasons; and 28 29 WHEREAS, the proposed maintenance increases the opportunity to 30 mitigate flooding in the area, reduces impacts to the homeowners, and is necessary to allow the stormwater system to reach its designed life span; and 31 WHEREAS, the stormwater pumping station located in the Northeast 32 section of the City connects to a 60-inch diameter piping system, which runs North

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to South on NE 14<sup>th</sup> Avenue, from Hallandale Beach Blvd to Atlantic Shores Boulevard; and

WHEREAS, Staff seeks a qualified vendor to perform maintenance to the Northeast section that will involve plugging the system in sections, desilting it, and inspect it for any repairs that may be needed, and Hinterland Group, Inc. proposed to do the work for an amount not to exceed two hundred sixty two thousand, one hundred twenty dollars (\$262,120); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 23-4, City of Hallandale Beach Code of Ordinances, all purchases of and contracts for equipment, supplies and contractual services, when the estimated cost shall exceed fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000.00), shall be based on competitive bids, unless subject to an exception to competitive bidding; and

WHEREAS, Staff recommends utilizing a contract competitively procured by other entities, the City of Fort Lauderdale, pursuant to Section 23-8(6), City of Hallandale Beach Code of Ordinances, as an exception to the Code's Section 23-4 competitive solicitation requirements: and

WHEREAS, on June 22, 2017, the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida, and Hinterland Group, Inc., entered into a contract pursuant to Fort Lauderdale's Invitation to Bid No. 473-11907 for Stormwater Construction Contract, which was renewed by the parties on June 3, 2020 until June 19, 2021; and

WHEREAS, Staff seeks City Commission's approval to retain the services of Hinterland Group, Inc. for the maintenance of large diameter storm water pipes in the Northeast section of the City utilizing the City of Fort Lauderdale's contract with Hinterland Group, Inc. through Invitation to Bid (ITB) No. 473-11907 for an amount not-to exceed two hundred sixty two thousand, one hundred twenty dollars (\$262,120) and to authorize the City Manager to execute related documents; and

**WHEREAS**, the Procurement department has approved the exception to competitive bidding requirements for this project.
