14	WHEREAS, the southeast section of the City's underground stormwater piping is				
15	an integral part of its flood management operations, and its connections flow directly				
16	through underground infrastructure out of the area through outfalls that discharge into the				
17	intercoastal waterway; and				
18					
19	WHEREAS, the effective functionality of this system is a necessary part of the				
20	strategy to remove stormwater from the City; and				
21					
22	WHEREAS, stormwater systems, often as a part of their operation, accumulate silt				
23	and debris over time, and the infrastructure where this accumulation occurs is				
24	underground requiring a large-scale operation to effectively perform the cleaning; and				
25 26	WHEREAS, while the City of Hellendele Reach has been reutinely maintaining and				
26 27	WHEREAS, while the City of Hallandale Beach has been routinely maintaining and				
27	cleaning the smaller diameter (15" and under) storm water pipes, City staff was never equipped nor had in place any means to clean the larger diameter pipe in the drainage				
29	system; and				
30					
31	WHEREAS, the accumulation of debris and sediments inside these large diameter				
32	pipes reduces the effective flow of stormwater, which increases the opportunity of flooding				
33	hazards during rainy seasons; and				
34					
35	WHEREAS, the proposed maintenance increases the opportunity to mitigate				
36	flooding in the area, reduces impacts to the homeowners, and is necessary to allow the				
37	stormwater system to reach its designed life span; and				
38					

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WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 23-4, City of Hallandale Beach Code of Ordinances, all purchases of and contracts for equipment, supplies and contractual services, when the estimated cost shall exceed fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000.00), shall be based on competitive bids, unless subject to an exception to competitive bidding; and

WHEREAS, Staff recommends utilizing a contract competitively procured by other
entities pursuant to Section 23-8(6), City of Hallandale Beach Code of Ordinances, as an
exception to the Code's Section 23-4 competitive solicitation requirements; and

48 WHEREAS, on June 3, 2017, the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida, and 49 Southeastern Engineering Contractors, Inc., entered into a contract pursuant to Fort 50 Lauderdale's Invitation to Bid No. 473-11907 for Stormwater Construction Contract, which 51 was renewed by the parties on June 3, 2020 until June 19, 2021; and

53 WHEREAS, Staff seeks City Commission's approval to retain the services of 54 Southeastern Engineering Contractors, Inc. for the maintenance of large diameter storm 55 water pipes citywide utilizing the City of Fort Lauderdale's contract with Southeastern 56 Engineering Contractors, Inc. through Invitation to Bid (ITB) No. 473-11907 for an amount 57 not-to exceed two hundred seventy one thousand, five hundred and thirty dollars 58 (\$271,530) and to authorize the City Manager to execute related documents; and

60 **WHEREAS**, the Procurement department has approved the exception to 61 competitive bidding requirements for this project.
