17 18	WHEREAS, on December 6, 2010, the City Commission entered into an
19	Agreement with Choice Environmental Services of Broward, Inc. ("Choice Broward") for
20	Transfer and Disposal of Solid Waste and Processing of Single Stream Recyclables
21	("Contract"); and
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23	WHEREAS, on January 1, 2012, the City and Choice Broward entered into a
24	Renewal of Agreement (the "First Amendment"); and
25 26	WHEREAS, Choice Broward was a wholly-owned subsidiary of Choice
27	Environmental Services, Inc. ("CES") at the time that the City and Choice Broward
28	entered into the Contract and First Amendment (collectively referred to as the
29	"Agreement"); and
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31	WHEREAS, CES was purchased by Waste Services of Florida, Inc. ("WSI") on
32	November 2012; and
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34	WHEREAS, WSI changed its name to Progressive Waste Solutions of FL, Inc.
35	on June 4, 2013; and
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37	WHEREAS, Choice Broward was merged into CES on August 16, 2013. With
38	CES being the surviving entity; and

40	WHEREAS, CES was merged into Progressive Waste Solutions of FL, Inc. or
41	September 19, 2013 with Progressive Waste Solutions of FL, Inc. being the surviving
42	entity; and
43	WHEREAS, over the past year the competitive market for solid waste disposa

WHEREAS, over the past year the competitive market for solid waste disposal has resulted in significant price decreases. As a result, staff has met with the current vendor (Progressive Waste Solutions of FL.) to discuss the reduction of rates prior to January 2015, the date the City could cancel the contract at the current contract prices. As a result of discussions with staff, Progressive Waste Solutions of FL. has proposed an agreement which would result in an immediate decrease in current rates; and

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WHEREAS, the City is amenable to amending and extending the Agreement to provide for an immediate reduction in current rates, including a rebate rate for recyclables conditioned upon the additional terms as set forth in the 2<sup>nd</sup> Amendment to Agreement attached as Exhibit "A", for an amount not to exceed one million one hundred twenty five thousand dollars (\$1,125,000.00); and

**WHEREAS,** City Staff recommends that the Mayor and City Commission approve the 2<sup>nd</sup> Amendment to Agreement to allow for an immediate decrease in current rates, including a rebate rate for recyclables; and authorize the City Manager to execute the 2<sup>nd</sup> Amendment to Agreement as conditioned upon the additional terms set forth therein.

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA:

**SECTION 1.** City Manager's Authorization. The Mayor and City Commission hereby approve the 2<sup>nd</sup> Amendment to Agreement as attached in Exhibit "A", and authorize the City Manager to execute the 2<sup>nd</sup> Amendment to Agreement in substantially the same form as attached as Exhibit A for an amount not to exceed one million one hundred twenty five thousand dollars (\$1,125,000.00).

**SECTION 2. Effective Date.** This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage and adoption.
