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12	WHEREAS, infiltration and inflow (I&I) is ground water that enters the City's sewer
13	system through cracks and/or breaches in the pipelines, which increases the volume of
14	sewage conveyed in the system and ultimately the amount paid to the City of Hollywood
15	by the City for wastewater treatment; and
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17	WHEREAS, the City has performed studies and rehabilitation work to 1) reduce
18	I&I throughout its wastewater collection system, 2) help to increase the system's capacity
19	for base and peak flows and 3) strengthen preventative maintenance and operations
20	activities by identifying and repairing any breaches/cracks in the pipelines, and broke the
21	work down to two phases known as Phase 2 - Mainline Repairs and Phase 2A - Lateral
22	Repairs; and
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24	WHEREAS, in connection with the first phase, on February 19, 2019, the City
25	released Invitation to Bid (ITB) FY 2018-2019-003 and is now near completion of Phase
26	2 - Mainline Repairs to reduce infiltration and inflow (I&I) throughout its wastewater
27	collection system; and
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29	WHEREAS, in connection with the second phase, on August 11, 2020, the City
30	released Invitation to Bid (ITB) FY 2019-2020-008 Infiltration and Inflow Removal Phase
31	2A - Lateral Repairs; and

33	WHEREAS, Invitation to Bid (ITB) FY 2019-2020-008 Infiltration and Inflow
34	Removal Phase 2A - Lateral Repairs was sent via email to over six hundred (600) vendors;
35	and
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37	WHEREAS, the three proposals received by the City were evaluated by the City's
38	consulting firm, Public Utility Management Planning Services, Inc., which firm found all
39	bids to be not responsible or non-responsive due to absence of direct experience, bond
40	requirements and contract bid sheet; and
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42	WHEREAS, pursuant to City of Hallandale Beach Code of Ordinances, Chapter
43	23, Section 23-12, Procedures for purchases in excess of \$50,000, (4) Rejection of Bids,
44	the City Commission may authorize City Manager to: a) Reject all bids; or b) reject all
45	bids and re-advertise; and
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47	WHEREAS, Staff recommends rejecting all bids and authorizing Staff to re-
48	advertise the second phase of the project and authorizing the City Manager to execute
49	any relating documents.
