16 17	WHEREAS, pursuant to Chapter 23, Section 23-8(5) Exception to Bid Requirements,		
18	Unique Circumstances, the City Commission may authorize non-competitive procurements if		
19	it finds unique circumstances to establish that competitive bidding is not in the best interest of		
20	the City; and		
21			
22	WHEREAS, an Agreement between the City of Hallandale Beach and Limousines of		
23	South Florida for Minibus Services (RFP # 2013-2014-002), began on June 1, 2014 and was		
24	in effect until September 2019; and		
25			
26	WHEREAS, on June 20, 2019, at the City Commission meeting it was adopted		
27	Resolution #2019-46, authorizing a month to month agreement as needed for up to six months		
28	under provisions of the existing contract with Limousines of South Florida Inc.; and		
29			
30	WHEREAS, on March 9, 2020, the City declared the state of emergency due to global		
31	pandemic of COVID-19. The state of emergency affected all busines and economies, and		
32	resulted in the inability for the City and Limousines of South Florida, Inc., to reach an		
33	agreement for the award of RFP FY 2018-2019-007, as solicited by the City and proposed by		
34	the Contractor; and		
35			
36	WHEREAS, in order to continue to provide free-fare shuttle bus service to the public		
37	without disruption, while the City pursues a new procurement process, the City and		
38	Limousines of South Florida, Inc., enter a six-month period from May1st 2020 to October 31s		
39	2020 under the City Manager's Emergency Powers at an increased cost of \$ 51.94 to reflect		
40	the increased maintenance cost of the aging fleet; and

42	WHEREAS, the City has ordered five (5) new	w propane fueled, ADA compliant, vehicles	
43	pursuant to the ILA with Broward County that hav	e been delayed due to production issues,	
44	but are expected in the Spring of 2021; and

46	WHEREAS, the City desires to continue pr	oviding Community Shuttle services to the	
47	public without disruption and Contractor is able to	continue providing services with the actual	
48	vehicle fleet under existing conditions until the end
