16	years, including a term as county mayor, and was twice elected to the Florida House of
17	Representatives; and
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19	WHEREAS, the conservation area sits off Martin, Palm Beach, Broward, and
20	Miami-Dade counties, running from the northern boundary of Biscayne National Park to
21	the St. Lucie Inlet; and
22	WHEREAS, Representative Jacobs was a champion in the creation of the
23 24	Conservation Area for the coral reef. The legislation put a "box" around the Southeast
25	Florida coral reef so that it could be studied and protected from disease and damage;

27	WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Commission of the City of Hallandale Beach
28	support the renaming of the Southeast Coral Reef Ecosystem Conservation Area after
29	the late Representative Kristin Jacobs in recognition of her legacy and tireless
30	championing of the environment.
