



BROWARD COUNTY MOBILITY ADVANCEMENT PROGRAM APPLICATION TRAINING FAQs

Thank you for your participation in yesterday's training session for the Municipal Capital Project (MCP) Application Website. We appreciate the feedback we've received so far and have put together this pamphlet of FAQs to help you navigate the application process.

FAQS FROM THE MCP APPLICATION TRAINING

Q *What information is required within the 28-day open application period for a project to be ranked?*

A The minimum information needed to rank a New MCP is:

- Project name
- Project description
- Project work type
- Project limits
- Project phase (planning, design, construction, design-build)
- Phase duration (number of months)
- Expected start of the phase (year)

To be considered for recommendation this round, you will need to fully complete the application for the phase in which you are requesting funding as well as provide a Resolution of Support and an independent cost estimate.

Q *Do New MCPs previously submitted and ranked 111-510 need to be resubmitted to be considered for funding?*

A Yes, MCPs previously ranked 111-510 need to be resubmitted. To streamline the process, these projects are pre-loaded into your list of MCPs once you log into your MAP account via the penny4transportation.org online portal. The minimum information needed to rank and recommend your MCPs listed in the previous answer applies to these projects as well.

Q *What is considered an independent cost estimate?*

A An independent cost estimate is either an estimate prepared by an organization independent of your municipality or an estimate prepared by you but reviewed and verified by another organization.

Q *What information needs to be submitted for Cycle 1 MCPs that have additional phases to be completed?*

A Cycle 1 MCPs approved by the Broward County Commission will maintain their ranking. We will support the County by reviewing the progress of these projects and verify that they are ready for the next phase of development. A series of readiness checks have been developed and will be provided to you once we start the process in early April 2021.
