- (1) The Ranked List of Municipal Surtax Capital Projects was developed by the Broward MPO in partnership with the municipalities in Broward County. All project information was provided by the municipalities.
- (2) All projects were provided by Broward County and were contained in the Surtax Plan approved by the voters in November 2018.
- (3) The Ranked List of Municipal Surtax Capital Projects, consistent with the Interlocal Agreement, is the output of the data-driven ranking tool utilizing the evaluation criteria, point distribution, and program readiness approach that was established in coordination with the municipalities.
- (4) Projects with numbers that include “.x” reflect multi-part projects.
