D/B/A WESTON NISSAN IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED THIRTY TWO THOUSAND TWO HUNDRED SIXTY TWO DOLLARS (\$32,262); AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO SIGN ALL RELATED DOCUMENTS; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.
14	WHEREAS, pursuant to Chapter 23, Section 23-8 Exception to Bid Requirements,
15	(6) Bids and Contracts from Other entities, and Section 23-9 Cooperative Purchasing, the
16	City Manager is authorized to procure all supplies, materials, equipment and services from
17	other governmental units, when the best interests of the City would be served subject to
18	the requirement that any purchase in excess of fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) requires
19	City Commission approval; and
20	WHEREAS, on January 6, 2021, the City Commission of Hallandale Beach
21	approved a budget amendment that included funding for the development of a parking
22	management program; and
23	WHEREAS, funding was approved for additional vehicles for parking enforcement
24	activities; and
25	WHEREAS, in consideration of the City's Sustainability Action Plan (SAP) goal of
26	reducing fossil fuel use by ten (10%) percent by 2022, and as the City strives to replace
27	ninety (90%) percent of baseline gasoline and diesel use with fuel efficiency or alternative
28	fuels, such as electricity, Staff is recommending the purchase of an electric vehicle for the
29	parking enforcement program; and
30	WHEREAS, Staff evaluated various electric vehicle options and determined that
31	the Nissan Leaf S Plus is the most viable option for parking enforcement due to its long
32	range 60 kW battery (226 miles), spacious interior, and price; and
33	WHEREAS, the Florida Sheriff's Association successfully completed its 28th
34	cooperative competitive bid for vehicles and, pursuant to Contract number FSA20-
35	VEL28.0, the Nissan Leaf S Plus is available to the City for cooperative purchase; and
36	WHEREAS, the purchase of the electric vehicle for the parking enforcement
37	program is in the interest of the City of Hallandale Beach, and Staff recommends that the
38	Mayor and City Commission authorize the utilization of the Florida Sheriff Association's

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39	cooperative agreement number FSA20-VEL28.0 to acquire one (1) electric vehicle for the
40	parking enforcement program in an amount not to exceed thirty two thousand, two
41	hundred and sixty two dollars (\$32,262); and authorize the City Manager to sign all related
42	documents.
43	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY
44	COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA:
45	SECTION 1. The foregoing "Whereas" clauses are incorporated herein.
46	SECTION 2. The Mayor and City Commission hereby authorize the utilization of
47	the Florida Sheriff Association's cooperative agreement number FSA20-VEL28.0 to
48	purchase one electric vehicle for the parking enforcement program in an amount not to
49	exceed thirty two thousand, two hundred and sixty two dollars (\$32,262); and authorize
50	the City Manager to sign all related documents.
51	SECTION 3. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage
52	and adoption.
