3 A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION
4 OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA,
5 AUTHORIZING THE MANAGER TO SUBMIT THE GRANT
6 APPLICATIONS FOR THE 47TH YEAR CDBG PROGRAM
7 FOR THE AFTER SCHOOL TUTORIAL PROGRAM AND
8 PUBLIC WORKS IMPROVEMENTS FOR A TOTAL
9 AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED TWO HUNDRED SIXTY SIX
10 THOUSAND THREE HUNDRED NINETY ONE (\$266,391)
11 DOLLARS; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO
12 EXECUTE ALL RELATED DOCUMENTS TO EFFECTUATE
13 THE SUBMITTAL OF THE GRANT APPLICATIONS,
14 ACCEPT GRANT AWARDS, AND EXECUTE ANY AND
15 ALL GRANT RELATED DOCUMENTS; AND PROVIDING
16 AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

19 **WHEREAS**, the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) program, run by
20 the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development, is a flexible program that
21 provides communities with resources to address a wide range of community development
22 needs; and
23

24 **WHEREAS**, cities participating in the Broward County CDBG program receive an
25 allocation based on a Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) funding
26 formula; and
27

28 **WHEREAS**, the formula generally takes into consideration community housing
29 conditions, population and poverty indicators; and

31 **WHEREAS**, the City plans to pursue two (2) projects during this CDBG funding
32 cycle: the After School Tutorial Program at the Hepburn Center for an amount not to
33 exceed one hundred six thousand, three hundred ninety one dollars (\$106,391) and
34 implement infrastructure upgrades for an amount not to exceed one hundred and sixty
35 thousand dollars (\$160,000), for a total combined amount not to exceed two hundred sixty
36 six thousand three hundred ninety one (\$266,391) dollars; and

38 **WHEREAS**, a public meeting was held virtually, via Zoom, on Monday, March 8,
39 2021 at 6:00 p.m. for feedback from the public. A second public hearing has been held
40 at the time of consideration of this resolution; and

41 **WHEREAS**, the Mayor and City Commission hereby find it is in the best interest
42 of the residents of the City of Hallandale Beach to authorize the application for the 47th
43 year CDBG programs.

45 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY**
46 **COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA:**



48 **SECTION 1.** The above clauses are incorporated in full in this Resolution.

50 **SECTION 2. City Manager's Authorization.** The Mayor and City Commission
51 hereby authorize the City Manager to submit the grant application for the 47th Year CDBG
52 Grant Program Project Public Works Drainage Improvements for an amount not to exceed
53 one hundred and sixty thousand dollars (\$160,000), and for After School Tutorial Program
54 for an amount not to exceed one hundred six thousand, three hundred ninety one dollars
55 (\$106,391), for a total combined amount not to exceed two hundred sixty six thousand
56 three hundred ninety one (\$266,391) dollars.

58 **SECTION 3.** The City Manager is authorized to establish accounts and
59 implement funding for the grant projects. Further, the City Manager is authorized to
60 execute all funding agreements with Broward County and appropriate funding allocation
61 documents following approval.

63 **SECTION 4. Effective Date.** This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon
64 its passage and adoption.
