| 23 | firms, Hazen and Sawyer, P.C. (Consultant), which permits the parties to execute |
| 24 | Work Authorizations for specific City projects from time to time that do not exceed |
| 25 | current CCNA statutory threshold amounts; and |

| 27 | WHEREAS, the City of Hallandale Beach owns, operates, and maintains |
| 28 | the water treatment plant serving approximately 40,000 people within the City's |
| 29 | corporate limits and seeks to continue utilizing City water for the longest extent |
| 30 | possible by incorporating provisions to the existing water treatment plant that can |
| 31 | accommodate higher salinity raw water; and |

| 33 | WHEREAS, to safeguard against future potential intrusion of saltwater into |
| 34 | the CITY's wellfield, the City will install one reverse osmosis (RO) skid within the |
| 35 | existing membrane treatment facility, capable of treating potential increasing saline |

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| 38 | project is \$3,650,000, below the statutory threshold; and |
