21	the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development, is a flexible program that
22	provides communities with resources to address a wide range of community development
23	needs; and
24	WHEREAS, cities participating in the Broward County CDBG program receive an
25	allocation based on a Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) funding
26	formula; and
27	WHEREAS, the formula generally takes into consideration community housing
28	conditions, population and poverty indicators; and
29	WHEREAS, the City plans to pursue two (2) projects during this CDBG funding
30	cycle in conjunction with the Friends of Hepburn Center Non-profit. The City hosted a
31	public meeting on March 3, 2020, wherein residents were advised of the City's plan to
32	continue the After School Tutorial Program at the Hepburn Center and implement
33	infrastructure upgrades under the City's application; and

SECTION 3. The City Manager is authorized to establish accounts and implement funding for the grant projects. Further, the City Manager is authorized to execute all funding agreements with Broward County and appropriate funding allocation documents following approval. SECTION 4. Effective Date.
