5 AUTHORIZING THE MANAGER TO SUBMIT THE GRANT
6 APPLICATIONS FOR THE 46TH YEAR CDBG PROGRAM
7 FOR THE AFTER SCHOOL TUTORIAL PROGRAM AND
8 PUBLIC WORKS IMPROVEMENTS IN THE NW
9 QUADRANT FOR A TOTAL AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED
10 TWO HUNDRED FORTY-THREE THOUSAND TWO
11 HUNDRED FORTY-ONE (\$243,241) DOLLARS;
12 AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ALL
13 RELATED DOCUMENTS TO EFFECTUATE THE
14 SUBMITTAL OF THE GRANT APPLICATIONS, ACCEPT
15 GRANT AWARDS, AND EXECUTE ANY AND ALL GRANT
16 RELATED DOCUMENTS; AND PROVIDING AN
17 EFFECTIVE DATE.

20 WHEREAS, the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) program, run by
21 the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development, is a flexible program that
22 provides communities with resources to address a wide range of community development
23 needs; and

24 WHEREAS, cities participating in the Broward County CDBG program receive an
25 allocation based on a Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) funding
26 formula; and

27 WHEREAS, the formula generally takes into consideration community housing
28 conditions, population and poverty indicators; and

29 WHEREAS, the City plans to pursue two (2) projects during this CDBG funding
30 cycle in conjunction with the Friends of Hepburn Center Non-profit. The City hosted a
31 public meeting on March 3, 2020, wherein residents were advised of the City's plan to
32 continue the After School Tutorial Program at the Hepburn Center and implement
33 infrastructure upgrades under the City's application; and

35 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY
36 COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA:

38 SECTION 1. The above clauses are incorporated in full in this Resolution.

40 SECTION 2. City Manager's Authorization. The Mayor and City Commission
41 hereby authorize the City Manager to submit the grant application for the 46th Year CDBG

Grant Program Project Public Works Improvements in the NW Quadrant (drainage, sidewalks, regrading/sodding of swales and other related infrastructure improvements) and for After School Tutorial Program for a total combined amount not to exceed two hundred forty-three thousand two hundred forty-one (\$243,241.00) dollars.

SECTION 3. The City Manager is authorized to establish accounts and implement funding for the grant projects. Further, the City Manager is authorized to execute all funding agreements with Broward County and appropriate funding allocation documents following approval.


SECTION 4. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage and adoption.
