13	WHEREAS, the City of Hallandale Beach currently provides Group Health, Group Dental,
14	Group Vision, Group Flexible Spending Accounts, Group COBRA, and Group Employee
15	Assistance Program (EAP) benefits to approximately 688 members, out of which 356 are eligible
16	employees and elected officials, and the rest are retirees and additional eligible dependents; and
17	
18	WHEREAS, previously, the City administration worked with the City's Insurance
19	Consultant, Gallagher Benefit Services, Inc., to initiate a Request For Proposals (RFP) to obtain
20	quotes from Group Health, Group Dental, Group Vision, Group Flexible Spending Accounts,
21	COBRA Administration and Group Employee Assistance Program (EAP) carriers, which was
22	ultimately awarded to AETNA; and
23	
24	WHEREAS, the 2020 insurance contract for group health coverage is due to expire
25	September 30, 2021. The other plans are in multiple year guarantees - Group Dental, Group
26	Vision, Group Flexible Spending Accounts, COBRA Administration, and Group Employee
27	Assistance Program (EAP), with Aetna; and
28	
29	WHEREAS, the City Manager, Human Resources Director and Gallagher consultants
30	negotiated a reduction in the initial proposed premium increased from 10.61% to 5% on the Health
31	Insurance benefits renewal rates; and
32	,
33	WHEREAS, based on the proposed insurance rates increase of 5% in our current Medical
34	annual premium, staff estimates the annual total benefits cost for Fiscal 2021/2021 to be
35	approximately \$6,907,667 (approximately an increase from FY 2020/2021 of \$968,086 annually),
36	although a final amount is pending the final "experience" reported by the plan; and
37	

38	WHEREAS, staff recommends the City Commission adopt the attached Resolution
39	authorizing the City Manager to execute the renewal agreement with Aetna.
40	
41	WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Commission have determined that it is in the best interest
42	of the City and its residents to accept the recommendation of the city administration.
43	
44	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY
45	COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA:

47	SECTION 1. The foregoing "Whereas" clauses are incorporated herein.

49	SECTION 2. The Mayor and City Commission hereby authorize the FY 21/22 renewal of
50	the agreement with AETNA pursuant to RFP FY 2018-2019-004, at a rate increase of five percent
51	(5%), for a total approximate cost of six million nine hundred seven thousand six hundred sixty-
52	seven (\$6,907,667) dollars, final cost pending additional negotiation. Authorizing the City
53	Manager to negotiate and execute the renewal agreement with the AETNA to provide group
54	health, group dental, group vision, group flexible spending accounts, COBRA administration,
55	medical gap insurance and group employee assistance program (EAP) benefits.
56	SECTION 3. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its
57	passage and adoption.
