L3 L4	WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 23-8(6) Bids and Contracts from other entities
L 5	the City Manager is authorized to procure all supplies, materials, equipment, and services
L6	pursuant to competitive bids and formal contracts of other governmental units when the
L7	best interests of the City would be served, subject to the requirement that any purchase
L8	in excess of \$50,000.00 requires City Commission approval; and

20	WHEREAS, pursuant to the Regional Interlocal Agreement between Broward
21	County and City of Hallandale Beach, the City has the responsibility to maintain the
22	systems necessary for the operations of the City's Fire Stations 7, 60, and 90; and
23	
24	WHEREAS, the City of Hallandale Beach is required to replace all fire station
25	alerting systems due to existing equipment reaching end-of-life cycle; and
26	
27	WHEREAS, currently, the City's existing equipment will reach its end-of-life cycle
28 29	by September 30, 2021 and will no longer be operational after this date; and
30	WHERAS, Broward County solicited via RFP R1426611P1 a Fire Station Alerting
31	System to support current and future fire department alerting needs for the County and
32	local public safety personnel; and
33	
34	WHEREAS, the purpose of the system is to provide end user departments with
35	enhanced fire station functions and interface with the computer-aided dispatch and public
36	safety systems as well as the Project 25 trunked radio systems necessary for the
37	operations of the City's Fire Stations 7, 60, and 90; and

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39	WHEREAS, to ensure City compliance with the Regional Interlocal Agreement,
40	Staff recommends City Commission approval to utilize a cooperative purchasing contract
41	through Broward County RFP R1426611P1 with Keylite Power & Lighting Corp. to replace
42	the City's existing fire alerting system equipment. City Staff also recommends City
43	Commission waive formal written contract for this purchase, and further authorize the City
44	Manager to effectuate this purchase with solely a purchase order.

46	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY
47	COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA:

49	SECTION 1. The foregoing "Whereas" clauses are incorporated herein.

51	SECTION 2. The Mayor and City Commission hereby authorize utilization of a
52	competitively solicited cooperative contract through Broward County RFP R1426611P1 a
53	Fire Station Alerting System with Keylite Power & Lighting Corp. to replace the City's
54	existing fire alerting system equipment at a cost of Three Hundred Fifty Three Thousand
55	Eighty-Three Dollars and Ninety-Five cents (\$353,083.95) plus a contingency of
56	Seventeen Thousand Six Hundred Fifty-Four Dollars and Twenty cents (\$17,654.20) for
57	a total not to exceed amount of Three Hundred Seventy Thousand Seven Hundred Thirty-
58	Eight Dollars and Fifteen Cents (\$370,738.15).

60	SECTION 3. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon
61	its passage and adoption.
