4 A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE  
5 CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA, ESTABLISHING THE  
6 TOTAL SUM OF THE ANNUAL FIRE PROTECTION SERVICES  
7 SPECIAL ASSESSMENT; SETTING THE AMOUNT ASSESSED  
8 AGAINST EACH PARCEL OF PROPERTY FOR THE 2021-2022 FISCAL  
9 YEAR; PROVIDING FOR THE CONTINUED USE OF THE UNIFORM  
10 METHOD OF COLLECTION; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.  
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13 WHEREAS, the City passed Ordinance No. 2000-16, as may be recodified,  
14 authorizing the imposition and collection of a fire protection services special assessment  
15 against property throughout the City; and

16 WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 8 of Ordinance No. 2000-16, the City utilizes the  
17 uniform method for levy, collection and enforcement of the assessment, as authorized by  
18 Chapter 197, Florida Statutes; and

19 WHEREAS, the projected cost for providing fire protection services to properties  
20 within the City that derive a special benefit from the availability of fire protection services has  
21 been evaluated; and

22 WHEREAS, Section 15 of Ordinance No. 2000-16 authorizes the annual  
23 modification of the total amount of the fire protection services special assessment and the  
24 amount assessed against each parcel of property.

25 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY  
26 COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA:

27 **SECTION 1.** The total annual cost for the provision of fire protection services to  
28 be paid through the levy and collection of special assessments against properties within the  
29 City is \$9,419,214 which represents ninety-five (95%) percent of the total fire protection  
30 services projected budget for the 2021-2022 fiscal year.

31 **SECTION 2.** In accordance with Ordinance No. 2000-16, and general law,  
32 properties are assessed for the 2021-22 fiscal year in the following apportionment:
