ORDINANCE NO. 2021-**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA, SETTING AND AMENDING THE WATER AND WASTEWATER RATES AND ADOPTING A WATER AND WASTEWATER RATE INCREASE FOR FISCAL YEAR 2021/2022; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Chapter 30, Article I, Section 30-3(b); Rates, fees, and charges generally. Any rate, fee, or charge provided for in this chapter shall be set as approved by the city commission; and

WHEREAS, notice of the proposed fee increase has been provided in accordance with Florida Statute Section 180.136.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. The foregoing "Whereas" clauses are confirmed as true and incorporated herein.

SECTION 2. The "Schedule of Fees and Charges" dated October 1, 2021, which is on file with the City Clerk, shall include the following, adopted as the schedule of fees and charges applicable in the City of Hallandale Beach for water and waste water charges and services rendered by the City, on or after October 1, 2021:

SECTION 4. Conflict. All ordinances, parts of ordinances, resolutions, or parts of resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed, to the extent of the conflict.

SECTION 5. Severability. Should any provision of this Ordinance be declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of this Ordinance as a whole or any portion thereof, other than the part that is declared to be invalid.

SECTION 6. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage and adoption.
