1 2 3 4 5 6 7 8 9 110 111 12 13	EXHIBIT 1 RESOLUTION NO. 2021- A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA, APPROVING AND ACCEPTING GRANT AWARD OF THE AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN ACT (ARPA) CORONAVIRUS LOCAL FISCAL RECOVERY IN THE AMOUNT OF \$19,957,515 DOLLARS FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF TREASURY THROUGH THE STATE OF FLORIDA DIVISION OF EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT (FDEM); AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ANY AND ALL GRANT DOCUMENTS TO EFFECTUATE ACCEPTANCE OF GRANT FUNDS; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

16 17 18 19	WHEREAS, the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 (ARPA) was signed into law on March 11, 2021, and will deliver \$350 billion for eligible state, local, territorial, and tribal governments to respond to the COVID -19 Pandemic; and
20	WHEREAS, funding provided under ARPA provides a unique opportunity for state and
21	local governments to make strategic investments in long-lived assets, rebuild reserves to enhance
22	financial stability, and cover temporary operating shortfalls until economic conditions and
23	operations normalize; and
24	
25	WHEREAS, under ARPA, states will receive approximately \$220 billion and local
26	governments will receive approximately \$130 billion, equally divided between cities and counties;
27	and
28	WHEREAS, for cities, \$65 billion is divided between Community Development Block Grant
29	(DCBG) entitlement jurisdictions and those that are not. Of this allocation, \$19.5 billion will be
30	allocated to non-entitlement cities; and
31	WUEDEAS antitlement cities will receive funds directly from the Department of the
32 33	WHEREAS, entitlement cities will receive funds directly from the Department of the Treasury, while non-entitlement cities will receive funds through their respective States; and
34	Trododry, wrine horr chalcomonic olaco will receive farios arrough their respective clates, and
35	WHEREAS, the City of Hallandale Beach is a non-entitlement City and will receive
36	\$19,957,515 dollars from the Department of Treasury through the State of Florida Division of

37	Emergency Management (FDEM). The first payment to the City will be disbursed upon execution
38	of the ARPA agreement and the second payment will be disbursed a year later; and

40	WHEREAS, funding for eligible expenditures must be expended or obligated by December
41	31, 2024 and cover expenditures from March 3, 2021 through December 31, 2024; and
42	
43	WHEREAS, funds obligated by December 31, 2024 must be expended by December 31,
44	2026; and
45	
46	WHEREAS, the Department of the Treasury has issued Interim Final Rule (2021-
47	10283.pdf (govinfo.gov), which sets forth the eligible uses of ARPA funds to include the following
48	four categories:
49	1. To respond to the public health emergency or its negative economic
50	impacts;
51	2. To respond to workers performing essential work during the COVID-19
52	public health emergency;
53	3. For the provision of government services to the extent of lost revenue
54	due to the COVID-19 pandemic; and
55	4. To make necessary investments in water, sewer, or broadband
56	infrastructure.
57	WHEREAS, ARPA funds will assist in the City's recovery from financial loss caused by
58	the COVID-19 Pandemic. Funds will be primarily slated to cover budget shortfalls by the amount
59	of revenue lost, which is calculated at various intervals pursuant to Interim Final Rule; and
60	
61	WHEREAS, ARPA funding is projected to be budgeted over the next three years as
62	presented during the FY 2021/22 budget process of the City's 5-Year Financial Strategy and
63	Projections discussion; and
64	
65	WHEREAS, on August 31, 2021, the City received its ARPA funding agreement from
66	FDEM, and in order to receive the first payment disbursement FDEM is urging grantees to execute
67	the funding agreement as soon as possible to ensure timely disbursement of funds; and
68	

69	WHEREAS, City Administration recommends City Commission approval and acceptance
70	of the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) Coronavirus Local Fiscal Recovery Fund Agreemen
71	and authorize the City Manager to execute any and all grant documents to effectuate acceptance
72	of grant funds.
73	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CIT
74	COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA:

76	SECTION 1 . The foregoing "Whereas" are incorporated herein.
77	SECTION 2. City Manager Authorization. The Mayor and City Commission hereb
78	approve and accept the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) Coronavirus Local Fiscal Recover
79	grant award in the amount of \$19,957,515 dollars from the Department of Treasury through the
80	State of Florida Division of Emergency Management (FDEM) and authorize the City Manager t
81	execute any and all grant documents to effectuate acceptance of grant funds.

83	SECTION 3. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon it
84	passage and adoption.
