SHORT TITLE:

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE UTILIZATION OF THE U.S. COMMUNITIES GOVERNMENT PURCHASING ALLIANCE COOPERATIVE CONTRACT RFP #17-21 FOR THE PURCHASE OF CLEANING SUPPLIES AND CUSTODIAL PRODUCTS FROM HOME DEPOT PRO INSTITUTIONAL IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED SEVENTY-SEVEN THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$77,000); AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ALL RELATED DOCUMENTS TO EFFECTUATE THE PURCHASE; AND PROVIDE FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

STAFF SUMMARY:

Summary:

Staff seeks City Commission approval to purchase various items through the contract with The Home Depot Pro Institutional utilizing the Omnia Partners/U.S. Communities Contract RFP #17-21.

Background:

The Procurement Department facilitates the purchase of specific commodities that the City procures annually through cooperative purchasing. As a member of the U.S. Communities and National IPA, both wholly owned subsidiaries of OMNIA Partners the City is able to participate and utilize competitively solicited contracts to obtain the best goods/services and pricing available in the market. The City wishes to purchase various items through The Home Depot Pro Institutional as described below for \$77,000.00.

OMNIA Partners is the largest and most trusted cooperative purchasing organization for public sector procurement. OMNIA Partners have brought together the nation's two leading cooperative purchasing organizations – National IPA and U.S. Communities – under one roof to form OMNIA Partners, Public Sector. The collective buying power of these unified purchasing cooperatives delivers superior value and savings for public agencies nationwide.

The City utilizes the OMNIA Partners\U.S. Communities Contract RFP # 17-21 with The Home Depot Pro Institutional for Cleaning Supplies, Equipment and Custodial Related Services and Solutions with the contract having a term through October 31, 2022. The City also utilizes Contract # 17-21 Janitorial Supplies & Equipment with a contract term through May 31, 2030.

Upon approval by the City Commission, authorized City staff to procure and make purchases online. Some of the purchases made by City staff include, but are not limited to, paper towels, facial tissues, wipers, dispensing equipment, seat covers, brooms and dust pans, can liners and restroom cleaners.

Cost Benefit:

The cost benefit and goal of public procurement is to award timely and cost-effective contracts to qualified contractors, suppliers, and service providers for the provision of goods, works and services to support national and local government, and public services operations, in accordance with principles and procedures established in the public procurement rules.

PROPOSED ACTION:

Staff recommends approval of the attached Resolution authorizing City Manager to execute all related documents to effectuate the purchases for FY 2020-2021 with The Home Depot Pro Institutional and OMNIA Partners\U.S. Communities Contract RFP # 17-21 in the amount of \$77,000.00.
