4 A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF
5 THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING
6 AN AGREEMENT WITH VALENTE BROTHERS JU-JITSU FOR
7 DEFENSIVE TACTICS TRAINING (VBDT) PROGRAM FOR AN
8 AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED ONE HUNDRED THIRTY-NINE
9 THOUSAND SIX HUNDRED AND EIGHTY DOLLARS
10 (\$139,680.00); AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.
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14 **WHEREAS**, pursuant to Section 23-8, Exception to bid requirements: (3) Noncompetitive
15 supplies. Noncompetitive supplies, available only from one source, such as unique, patented, or
16 franchised supplies, are exempt. The city manager is authorized to purchase and contract for
17 noncompetitive supplies in excess of \$50,000; and
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19 **WHEREAS**, de-escalation is an essential asset within law enforcement, with officers often
20 placed in unfortunate situations where force is necessary to protect the community or effect an
21 arrest; and
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23 **WHEREAS**, tied into de-escalation is the ability of the officers to utilize sufficient force to
24 meet any resistance; and
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26 **WHEREAS**, while use of force and defensive tactics training is an annual requirement by
27 the Florida Department of Law Enforcement (FDLE), it is recommended that officers continue
28 working on their skillset as their career's progress; and
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30 **WHEREAS**, with many outlets for training, VBDT presents a unique opportunity for officers
31 to enhance their skillsets through a law enforcement-focused curriculum. The services by VBDT
32 will provide law enforcement personnel with four (4) training days per month over a seven (7)
33 month period; and
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35 **WHEREAS**, the cost of the VBDT training is \$139,680 dollars and is reimbursable under
36 the current Inter-Local Agreement (ILA) between the Hallandale Beach Police Department

37 (HBPD) and the Community Redevelopment Agency (HBCRA) for the procurement of VB
38 training for all sworn law enforcement officers; and

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40 **WHEREAS**, the ILA agreement provides for the reimbursement of services procured from
41 VB in the amount of \$139,680.00 dollars; and

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43 **WHEREAS**, the HBPD has a strong commitment to the continual development of its sworn
44 police officer's skills and abilities, which VB training will continue to build upon from HBPD's
45 prior de-escalation training taken in February, 2020; and

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47 **WHEREAS**, the Mayor and City Commission have determined that engaging the services
48 of Valente Brother Ju-jitsu Defensive Tactics Training Program is in the best interest of the City
49 of Hallandale Beach's Police Department law enforcement personnel and the City.

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51 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY**
52 **COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA:**

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54 **SECTION 1. City Manager's Authorization.** The Mayor and City Commission hereby
55 authorize the City Manager to execute an Agreement with Valente Brothers Ju-jitsu for Defensive
56 Tactics Training (VB) Program for an amount not to exceed one hundred thirty-nine thousand
57 six hundred and eighty dollars (\$139,680.00); and authorize the City Manager to execute all
58 necessary documents to effectuate the engagement of said services.

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60 **SECTION 2. Effective Date.** This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its
61 passage and adoption.
