A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING USE OF CONTINUING SERVICE AGREEMENT TO RETAIN THE SERVICES OF AECOM TECHNICAL SERVICES, INC. TO DESIGN THE 18 INCH FORCE MAIN ALONG LAYNE BOULEVARD PROJECT IN AN AMOUNT NOT-TO-EXCEED TWO HUNDRED EIGHTY-ONE THOUSAND, THREE HUNDRED TWENTY-FIVE DOLLARS AND TWO CENTS (\$281,325.02); AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, on August 5, 2020, the City Commission of Hallandale Beach adopted Resolution 2020-054 authorizing continuing service agreements solicited through RFP #2018-2019-012 – Continuing Professional Architectural and Engineering Services pursuant to Section 287.055, F.S., the Consultants Competitive Negotiation Act (CCNA); and

WHEREAS, effective December 15, 2020, the City of Hallandale Beach entered into its CCNA agreement with one of the selected design professional firms, AECOM Technical Services, Inc. (the “Firm”), which permits the parties to execute Work Authorizations for specific City projects from time to time that do not exceed current CCNA statutory threshold amounts; and

WHEREAS, design of the 18 Inch Force Main along Layne Blvd was identified by the City’s consultant in the Wastewater Masterplan, and includes approximately 2,800 linear feet of 18 Inch force main either by horizontal directional drill or open cut or a combination of both from Pump Station No. 1 to Egret Drive to Layne Blvd and crossing Hallandale Beach Blvd to connect into the existing 14-inch FM pipe, which then increases to a 16-inch FM pipe on the north side; and
