15 16	WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 23-6, Award of Contracts, and 23-8, Unique
17	Circumstances, the City Commission may declare unique circumstances as an exception
18	to the requirements of competitive bidding; and

20	WHEREAS, unlike the procurement of most services, insurance products must be
21	obtained through a broker who is paid a commission by the insurance company and not
22	the city;
23	
24	WHEREAS, market forces that typically apply during a competitive procurement
25	process are further restricted because the City participates in the Florida Municipal
26	Insurance Trust Fund, which is administered by the Florida League of Cities and limited
27	only to municipalities, to insure its physical facilities; and
28 29	WHEREAS, the City is required to comply with the provisions of Florida Statute
30	440 by maintaining a Self-Insurance Fund; and
31	
32	WHEREAS, the purpose is to ensure that if an employee is injured on the job, the
33	worker will receive quick and efficient disability and medical benefits, if needed; and
34 35	WHEREAS, there are numerous governmental agencies throughout the State of
36	Florida that participate in this pooled program; and
37	
38	WHEREAS, the City Administration is recommending that the City retain Florida
39	Municipal Trust Fund as its workers' compensation insurance provider for the total sum of

44	insurance through the Florida Municipal Insurance Trust Fund is the most cost effective		
45	for the City and in the best interest of the residents of the City.

56	SECTION 3. City Manager Authorization. The Mayor and City		
57	Commission hereby approve the renewal of the City's workers' compensation insurance		
58	through the Florida Municipal Insurance Trust Fund in the estimated amount of one		
59	hundred fifty-four thousand eight hundred sixty-two (\$154,862) dollars as provided for in		
60	fiscal year 2021-22 budget, subject to the adjustment resulting from the required annual		
61	audit and authorizing the City Manager to execute all related documents to effectuate the		
62	renewal of the City's workers' compensation insurance.
