16 17	WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 23-6, Award of Contracts, and 23-8, Unique		
17 18	Circumstances, the City Commission may declare unique circumstances as an exception to the requirements of competitive bidding;		
18 19	requirements of competitive bloding,		
20	WHEREAS, unlike the procurement of most services, insurance products must be		
21	obtained through a broker who is paid a commission by the insurance company and not the city;		
22			
23	WHEREAS, the City participates in the Florida Municipal Insurance Trust Fund, which is		
24	administered by the Florida League of Cities and limited only to municipalities, to insure its		
25	physical facilities; and		
26			
27	WHEREAS, this trust fund provides property insurance for all City facilities which currently		
28 20	totals \$98,416,754 for buildings and \$6,663,000 for content coverage. There is a \$25,000		
29 30	deductible per incident except for windstorm damage, which is 5% per value of the building deductible; and		
31			
32	WHEREAS, the property insurance for all City facilities provided by this trust fund		
33	represents the cost to replace damaged property with property of like kind and quality; and		
34 35	WHEREAS, the City Administration is recommending that the City renew its current		
36	property insurance with Florida Municipal Trust Fund for the total sum of Eight Hundred Fifteen		
37	Thousand Three Hundred Fifty-Five (\$815,355) Dollars for fiscal year 2021-2022; and		
38 39	WHEREAS, the City believes it is in the best interest of the City to renew the City's current		
40	property insurance through the Florida Municipal Insurance Trust Fund.

54	(\$815,355) Dollars and authorize the City Manager to execute all related documents to effectuate		
55	the renewal of the City's property insurance.
