8 9	UPDATE RELATING TO MITIGATING THE HAZARDOUS EFFECTS OF FLOODING; AND		
10	PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.		
11 12	WHEREAS, as a participant in the National Flood Insurance Program's (NFIP)		
13	Community Rating System (CRS) Program, the City of Hallandale Beach has		
14	implemented a series of public information outreach projects to educate the community		
15	on flood hazard and flood protection to provide the public with information needed to		
16	increase flood hazard awareness and to motivate actions to reduce flood damage,		
17	encourage flood insurance coverage, and protect the natural functions of floodplains; and		
18			
19	WHEREAS, the 2017 CRS Manual strongly recommends that communities		
20	formalize their outreach projects by developing a flood mitigation education and outreach		
21	Program for Public Information (PPI); and		
22			
23	WHEREAS, the City of Hallandale Beach PPI Working Group assesses the		
24	community's need for public information; formulates the messages; identifies the outreach		
25	projects to convey the message; examines other public information initiatives; and		
26	establishes a process to monitor and evaluate the program; and		
27			
28	WHEREAS, the CRS program requires a PPI Update to be adopted by the		
29	community through formal approval by the community's governing body; and		
30			
31	WHEREAS, absent a robust, substantive public outreach program, the City of		
32	Hallandale Beach's CRS Class 6 rating could be adversely affected; were it to fall to a		
33	Class 7 rating, the existing community-wide savings on flood insurance premiums could		
34	be reduced from \$1,120,000 to \$836,000, rendering such insurance less affordable; and		
35			

36	WHEREAS, Staff recommends that the City Commission adopt the City's		
37	Program for Public Information (PPI) Update relating to mitigating the hazardous effects		
38	of flooding.

40	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY		
41	COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA:

43	SECTION 1. The foregoing "Whereas" clauses are incorporated herein.

45	SECTION 2. The Mayor and City Commission hereby adopt the City's		
46	Program for Public Information (PPI) Update relating to mitigating the hazardous effects		
47	of flooding.

49	SECTION 3. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its		
50	passage and adoption.
