10	WHEREAS, the City of Hallandale Beach has been a participating
11	community in the National Flood Insurance Program's Community Rating System
12	Program (NFIP/CRS) since 1995; and
13	WHEREAS, the CRS is a voluntary incentive program that assesses a
14	community's ability to mitigate flood damage, and it encourages community
15	floodplain-management activities that exceed the minimum NFIP requirements
16	and
17	WHEREAS, participation in the CRS rating Program yields a direct benefit
18	to City property owners through a reduction in their flood insurance premiums, and
19	this year the City of Hallandale Beach has maintained a Class 6 rating
20	unsurpassed in Broward County, earning City property owners a combined annua
21	reduction in flood insurance premiums of approximately \$1,000,000; and
22	WHEREAS, one of the rating activities in the CRS program is "Floodplair
23	Management Planning," an analysis of the community's vulnerability to flooding
24	and a comprehensive investigation of possible activities that can be undertaken to
25	help mitigate the hazardous effects of flooding in the community; and
26	WHEREAS, the Floodplain Management Plan must be updated
27	approximately every five (5) years in order to continue to meet the CRS Program
28	requirement; and

29	WHEREAS, the City's 2021 Floodplain Management Action Plan was
30	presented to the residents at a Public Meeting on, August 12, 2021, and was
31	approved by the City's Ad Hoc CRS Committee on August 19, 2021; and
32	WHEREAS, by participating in the CRS program, the City is allowing its
33	residents living in the Special Flood Hazard Area (SFHA) to obtain a twenty (20%)
34	discount on their flood insurance premium, and its resident living outside the SFHA
35	to obtain a ten (10%) discount on their flood insurance premium; and
36	WHEREAS, Staff recommends that the Mayor and City Commission adop
37	the 2021 City of Hallandale Beach Floodplain Management Plan Update.
38	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE
39	CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA:
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41	SECTION 1. The foregoing "Whereas" clauses are incorporated herein.
42	SECTION 2. The Mayor and City Commission hereby adopt the 2021 City
43	of Hallandale Beach Floodplain Management Plan Update, and authorize the City
44	Manager to sign any related documents.
