14		WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Commission find that the City's Code of Ordinances	
15	providing for the compensation and expenses of the City Commission should be revised to		
16	addre	ss the travel expenses of the Commission.

18	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION		
19	OF TI	HE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA:

21	•	SECTION 1. Chapter 2 Administration, Article II. City Commission, Section 2-31,	
22	Comp	pensation and expenses of the City's Code of Ordinances is amended as follows:	
23	ADTI	CLE II. CITY COMMISSION	
24 25		2-31. Compensation and expenses.	
25 26	(a)	Salary. The salary of the Mayor and Commissioners shall be presented as part of the	
20 27	<u>(a)</u>	annual budget. The salary presented will be the same as the previous year salary,	
28		but adjusted to include the same annual cost-of-living adjustment as applicable to	
29		members of the general employee bargaining unit and may be approved as part of	
30		the annual budget. However, in the event the Mayor or a commissioner wish to	
31		adopt a salary that differs from the salary in the previous sentence, the subject must	
32		be included and voted on as a separate item on the agenda at the first of the two	
33		public hearings of the annual budget.	
34			
35	<u>(b)</u>	Other benefits. The Mayor and Commissioners shall be eligible for all health and	
36		non-pension retirement benefits applicable to members of the general employee	
37		bargaining unit. However, members of the commission may elect to obtain the cash ORD. NO. 2021-	

38	equivalent of health coverage if they show proof they are otherwise covered by
39	health insurance for the year.
40	(c) <u>Travel Expenses.</u> Commissioners shall be reimbursed for their actual and necessary
41	travel expenses incurred in the performance of their duties of office as preauthorized
42	by the city commission. Authorized travel for the purposes of this paragraph shall be
43	limited to those expenses necessarily incurred in the performance of a public
44	purpose related to the duties or office of a commissioner. Authorized travel expenses
45	will be reimbursed in accordance with Florida Statute, as applicable to municipal
46	legislative officers. Each annual budget shall contain an annual allotment for
47	commission travel expenses.
48	(1) Preauthorized travel. Each commissioner may be reimbursed up to 1/5 <sup>th</sup>
49	(one-fifth) of the commission's total annual allotment of the commission for actual
50	authorized travel without seeking commission approval for the specific travel. Travel
51	within that allotment shall be considered preauthorized for the purposes of this
52	section.
53	(2) Any travel expense that exceeds an individual member of the
54	commission's annual allotment must be approved by motion of the commission prior
55	to incurring the expense.
56	
57	SECTION 2. Conflict. All ordinances or portions of the Code of Ordinances of the
58	City of Hallandale Beach in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance shall be repealed to
59	the extent of such conflict.
60	SECTION 3. Severability. Should any provision of this ordinance be declared by a
61	court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, the same shall not affect the validity of the
62	ordinance as a whole, or any part thereof, other that the part declared to be invalid.
63	SECTION 4. Codification. It is the intention of the Mayor and the City Commission
64	that the provisions of this ordinance be incorporated into the Code of Ordinances; to effect
65	such intention the words "ordinance" or "section" may be changed to other appropriate
66	words.
67	SECTION 5. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upor
68	adoption on second reading.
