13	WHEREAS, pursuant to Chapter 23, Section 23-8(6) Bids and Contracts from		
14	Other entities, and Section 23-9 Cooperative Purchasing, the City Manager is authorized		
15	to procure all supplies, materials, equipment and services from other governmental units,		
16	when the best interests of the City would be served subject to the requirement that any		
17	purchase in excess of \$50,000.00 requires City Commission approval; and		
18	WHEREAS, the Police fleet is comprised of approximately 130 vehicles, excluding		
19	boats and trailers, of which 65 vehicles are past due for replacement as far back as		
20	FY2015-2016 through FY2020-2021. Five (5) vehicles are due for replacement in		
21	FY2021-2022; and		
22	WHEREAS, of the 65 past due vehicles for replacement, staff has prioritized fifty-		
23	one (51) law enforcement vehicles to be replaced; and		
24	WHEREAS, funding for these purchases will come from the Fleet Fund and the		
25	American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA). Staff also anticipates sometime in fiscal year (FY22)		
26	a budget amendment will be brought to City Commission which approves the replacement		
27	of an additional fourteen (14) law enforcement vehicle which are due to be replaced in		
28	FY2021-2022; and		
29	WHEREAS, the fifty-one (51) law enforcement vehicles will be replaced with thirty-		
30	eight (38) hybrid and thirteen (13) electric vehicles, which is in line with the City's 50by30		
31	Climate Action Plan and Net-Zero Goal. It is also estimated that the fifty-one vehicles will		
32	reduce the City operations greenhouse gas emissions by as much as 5%; and		
33	WHERAS, staff seeks City Commission authorization to purchase thirteen (13) of		
34	the fifty-one (51) vehicles utilizing Contract #FSA20-VEL28. The per unit cost of the Telsa		
35	Y vehicles is \$51,290.00, which does not include Police outfitting; and		

36 37	WHEREAS, outfitting the vehicles with procured separately and is estimated to be with	h lights and sirens and decals will be in city manager purchasing authority; and	
38 39	WHEREAS, as to the remaining thirty-eight (38) law enforcement vehicles, a separate agenda item will be brought before the City Commission for authorization utilizing		
40	a separate contract.
