RESOLUTION NO. 2021-**

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA, AFFIRMING ACCEPTANCE OF FAITHACTION ID CARDS FOR CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH SERVICES; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Commission of Hallandale Beach, recognizes that currently photographic identification is necessary to access many important services such as banking, health care , and government programs; and

WHEREAS, it is often challenging for residents in Hallandale Beach, including, but not limited to, elderly individuals, formerly-incarcerated persons, foster youth, homeless persons, transgender persons, and persons struggling to overcome the bureaucratic challenges of getting a state-issued identification card, to obtain government-issued identification; and

WHEREAS, the FaithAction ID card is an identification card that is accessible to those who cannot acquire a government identification card and serves as a verifiable form of identification that can be used as a tool by law enforcement, health centers, schools, nonprofits, businesses, cultural arts organizations, and other entities to better identify, serve, and protect our community members; and

WHEREAS, the FaithAction ID program conforms to strict verification of identity and security standards by requiring card applicants to provide proof of identity, proof of address, and proof of date of birth as required by Section 877.18, Florida Statutes; and

WHEREAS, the Commission desires to encourage government agencies, business leadership, civic groups, community institutions, and residents to join in a communitywide effort to expand prosperity and inclusion for all residents by accepting or adoption FaithAction ID cards or other forms of municipal identification cards; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HALLANDALE BEACH, FLORIDA:

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SECTION 1. The Mayor and City Commission hereby affirm that the ability to obtain and use a FaithAction ID card will be of assistance to homeless individuals, persons reentering the community after incarceration, and those who do not have a driver license, and is a benefit to the general welfare of the City. will recognize and accept FaithAction ID cards as appropriate identification to access City services unless another form of identification is required by local, state, or federal law.

SECTION 2. The City Commission urges and encourages business leadership, civic groups, other government agencies, community institutions, and residents to recognize and participate in the FaithAction ID program by recognizing the FaithAction ID card as valid identification as part of a communitywide effort to expand prosperity and inclusion for all residents.

SECTION 3. **Effective Date.** This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage and adoption.
