WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 23-9 of the City of Hallandale Beach ("City")
Code, the City Manager shall have the authority to join with other units of government in
cooperative purchasing plans or to purchase pursuant to formal written contracts or
competitive bids of other governmental units, when the best interests of the City would be
served, subject to the requirement that purchases in excess of \$50,000 require City
Commission approval; and

WHEREAS, the City participates in the Southeast Florida Governmental Purchasing Cooperative ("Co-op") which is comprised of governmental entities to provide cost savings and cost avoidances to member entities by utilizing the buying power of combined requirements for common basic items; and

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WHEREAS, the City of Tamarac, acting as lead agency for the Co-op, awarded Bid #20-21B for the purchase of quicklime to Lhoist North America of Alabama, LLC through Resolution R-2020-095 for a term of three (3) years, beginning November 1, 2020, with up to three (3) one (1) year renewals to be exercised based upon satisfactory performance ("Co-op contract"); and

- WHEREAS, the City Administration projects that the expenditure for quicklime for
 Fiscal Year 2021-2022 will be two hundred sixty-five thousand dollars (\$265,000); and

40	purchase quicklime for water treatment plant operations for Fiscal Year 2021-2022.

46	hereby authorize the City Manager to purchase quicklime utilizing the Southeast Florida
47	Governmental Purchasing Cooperative contract pursuant to Bid #20-21B between the City
48	of Tamarac and Lhoist North America of Alabama, LLC for an amount not to exceed two
49	hundred sixty-five thousand dollars (\$265,000) for fiscal year FY 2021-2022. The City
50	Manager is authorized to take necessary actions to implement the project.

52	SECTION 2. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon
