DISCUSSION REGARDING LEGISLATIVE PRIORITIES FOR THE 2022 STATE LEGISLATIVE PROGRAM AND DIRECT APPROPRIATION REQUESTS

STAFF SUMMARY:

Summary:

Staff seeks input from the City Commission regarding legislative priorities and direct appropriation requests for inclusion in the City of Hallandale Beach 2022 State Legislative Program.

Background:

Throughout the year the City Commission discusses various issues for submittal to the Broward County Legislative Delegation and the State Legislators for consideration during the Legislative Session. The 2022 Legislative Session is scheduled to commence in January 2022.

Current Situation:

Ballard Partners, Inc., the City's lobbying firm, seeks to update the City Commission on recommended priorities for the 2022 Legislative Program and to provide guidance on the submittal of direct appropriation requests. Appropriation requests are due no later than November 17th. The City of Hallandale Beach 2021 State Legislative Program is attached for reference (Exhibit 1).

As discussed with Ballard Partners, Inc., staff will focus on the following three areas for the formulation of direct appropriation requests for the upcoming session:

- Construction funding for water, sewer and stormwater infrastructure
- Level funding for the Austin Hepburn Senior Mini Center
- Construction funding for the Electric Vehicle Parking and Charging Facility

Why Action is Necessary:

Discussion with the City Commission is necessary to provide direction to staff and to our lobbying firm, Ballard Partners, Inc., to draft the City's 2022 Legislative Program for City Commission adoption before the commencement of the upcoming session, and for authorization to submit direct appropriation requests no later than November 17, 2021.

Cost Benefit:

The City will benefit from the potential receipt of state funding and related savings resulting from the advocacy of State Legislators.

PROPOSED ACTION:

City Commission provide input on legislative priorities to be included in the City's 2022 State Legislative Program and authorize staff and Ballard Partners, Inc. to submit direct appropriation requests on behalf of the City of Hallandale Beach.
